 - Associate: Any Adhoc/Guest Faculty currently working or Research Scholar currently pursuing or completed his/her doctoral research ONLY from University of Delhi, its affiliated Departments, Centres and Colleges in Social Sciences or allied disciplines or from a discipline which the Research Committee deems suitable can apply to be considered for appointment as an Associate.

> What the Fellows and Associates are expected to do?

- To work for a minimum number of hours per week [not less than 6-8 hours] at the Centre and participate in all its academic and research activities.
- To publish at least two papers in reputed refereed journals/UGC CARE list journals during the period of Fellowship.
- To solicit funds for research projects from various funding agencies.
- To make formal presentations about the progress of his/her research every six months and also submit, at the end of every year a detailed report about the research work done and academic progress made.
- Their performance and contribution to the Centre shall be assessed by the Research Committee from time to time.
- Summarily, the Fellows and Associates are expected to work towards fulfilling the objectives of the Centre as outlined in Ordinance XX (9) 1 of the University of Delhi.
- Fellows and Associates shall work at the Centre in addition to the full-time work at their respective colleges/departments/institutions.
- No salary/honorarium/remuneration shall be given, other than what may be admissible, as per rules.
