The letter of the Ministry of Defence which is originally addressed to the Secretary, UGC with a copy to the Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi mentions that “the Indian Coast Guard is an Armed Force of the Union, under Ministry of Defence. The Indian Coast Guard personnel are governed by the Coast Guard Act, 1978 and are under the administrative control of Ministry of Defence. This issues with the approval of Joint Secretary (Armed Forces), Ministry of Defence.”

The committee was also informed about the Gazette Notification with respect to the Tatrakshak Medal (Gallantry award) given to one officer of the Indian Coast Guard. A copy of the President Secretariat list was also placed before the Committee wherein following is observed.




