MINUTES

Minutes of the Standing Committee of the Academic Council under Clause 5 of Ordinance –II of the Ordinance of the University for Admissions of 2024-25 was held on 23.11.2023 at 11:30 A.M. in Council Hall of the University.

Dean (Faculty of Education), Dean (Faculty of Music & Fine Arts), Dean (Faculty of Management Studies), Dean (Faculty of Ayurvedic & Unani Medicine), Dean Faculty of Commerce & Business, Dean (Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine) and Dean (Faculty of Open Learning) could not attend the meeting because of other preoccupations.

At the outset, Registrar, University of Delhi welcomed Prof. Amitava Chakaraborty, Dean, Faculty of Arts as Chairman of the Standing Committee related to admission of the Academic Council under Clause-5 of Ordinance-II of Ordinance of the University for admissions 2024-25.

The Committee also acknowledged the contribution of Prof. Satish Awasthi, Dean, Faculty of Sciences, University of Delhi during his Chairmanship of Standing Committee related to admission of the Academic Council under Clause-5 of Ordinance-II of Ordinance of the University for admissions 2023-24.

The Committee appreciated the initiatives taken by the Admission Branch, University of Delhi for the smooth and seamless completion of Admissions to all the Undergraduate, Postgraduate, B.Tech, ITEP, BA LLB(H), BBA LLB (H) PG-Merit-based and Ph.D. programs for the academic session 2023-24. under the leadership of Prof. Hancet Gandhi, Dean, Admissions. The Committee observed that the admissions were done in a smooth, transparent manner with minimum grievances.

The Chairman, Standing Committee welcomed all the members and requested the Dean, Admissions to place the agenda.

After detailed deliberation upon the agenda, the following were resolved and recommended for the approval of the Academic Council:

1. CONSIDERATION ITEMS

1.1 Eligibility criteria of UG programs under CUET (UG) 2024-25 for the academic session 2024-25.

The Committee considered and approved the Eligibility Criteria of UG programs under CUET (UG) 2024-25 for the academic session 2024-25 (Annexure I).



The Committee also approved the Program-specific eligibility for the newly introduced B.A (Hons) Russian program in the Department of Slavonic and Finno-Ugrian Studies from the academic session 2023-24. (Annexure I).

The Committee unanimously approved to provide equitable opportunity to all, therefore admissions to all Undergraduate programs in all Colleges for the academic session 2024-25 will be done solely on the scores of Common University Entrance Test (CUET (UG).

Eligibility criteria of PG programs under CUET (PG) 2024-25 for the academic session 2024-25.

The Committee considered and approved the Eligibility Criteria of PG programs under CUET (PG) 2024-25 for the academic session 2024-25 (Annexure II).

The Committee also recommended that from the academic session 2024-25, the admission to following programs may also done on the basis of CUET(PG) 2024-25 (Annexure II):

- 1. M.A. Hindu Studies
- 2. M.A. Chinese
- 3. M.A. Korean

The Committee unanimously approved to provide equitable opportunity to all, admissions to all Postgraduate programs in all Departments/ Colleges/ Centres for the academic session 2024-25 will be will be done solely on the scores of the Common University Entrance Test (CUET (PG).

1.2 Eligibility criteria and admission process of 4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the academic Session 2024-25.

The Committee unanimously recommended the Eligibility criteria for 4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the academic Session 2024-25 will be the same as it was in the academic session 2023-2024.

1.3 Eligibility criteria of B.Tech. programs – (i) B.Tech. (Computer Science and Engineering), (ii) B.Tech. (Electronics and Communication Engineering)) and (iii) B.Tech. (Electrical Engineering) for the academic session 2024-25.

The Committee unanimously recommended that the Eligibility criteria of B.Tech. programs – (i) B.Tech. (Computer Science and Engineering), (ii) B.Tech. (Electronics and Communication Engineering)) and (iii) B.Tech. (Electrical Engineering) for the academic session 2024-25 will be the same as it was in the academic session-2023-24.

Admissions to these programs will be done on the basis of the All India Common Rank List (CRL) of the Joint Entrance Examination (Main) Paper-I, 2024.

1.4 Eligibility criteria and admission process of BA LLB (Hons) and BBA LLB (Hons) for the academic session 2024-25.

The Committee was apprised about the Court case WPC NO. 10737 OF 2023 TITLED PRINCE SINGH VS FACULTY OF LAW UNIVERSITY OF DELHI & DELH



In the Petition it has been insisted / prayed for directions to admit students on the basis of CUET score only in place of the CLAT.

In this background it was also apprised that the Academic Council and Executive Council vide its meeting dated 26th -27th May 2023 and 09th June, 2023 on the basis of the recommendation of the Workload Assessment Committee duly constituted by the Vice-Chancellor University of Delhi, resolved that the admissions to the said two 5- year Integrated Law Programmes are to be done based on merit by taking into consideration score under CLAT-2023.

During the hearing of the matter by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi on 18.09.2023, the following was recorded at para 7 of its order:

"7. Crucial issues are involved in the present case which require consideration. The pertinent question is whether admissions are to be granted in the Central Universities only on the basis of CUET and whether Central Universities are at a liberty to admit students through other examinations conducted by other specialized agencies. However, for the present academic year 2023-24, as classes have already started, by way of interim relief, DU is permitted to admit students to its Five-Year Integrated Law Course based on CLAT UG-2023.

Given the importance of the issues raised in the present case, Mr. Anuj Bhardwaj, learned Senior Counsel is appointed as Amicus Curiae to assist this Court in this matter. Registry of this Court is directed to furnish the complete set of documents in this matter to Mr. Anuj Bhardwaj, to enable him to assist this Court."

As allowed by the Hon'ble Court the admissions to the %-year LL. B Integrated Programme has been done on the basis of CLAT score-2023. The Standing Committee has also discussed the communication of the UGC no. D.O. no. 13-11/2020 (CU) Dated 27.09.2023 addressed to all the Vice-Chancellors of the Central Universities, which is reproduced as under:

"This is in continuation to the UGC letter of even number, dated 10th March, 2023. As you are aware, on the basis of the decision taken by the University Grants Commission in its 566 meeting, held on 23rd February, 2023, all the Central Universities were requested to take appropriate measures for admission in all the Undergraduate programmes through CUET for the academic session 2023-24. I would like to share with you that the Commission in its 572nd meeting held on 20th September, 2023 has decided that & quoted CUET shall be mandatory for admission in all the Undergraduate Programmes, except professional courses such as in Engineering, Medical, Law etc., in all the Central Universities.

In view of the above, you are requested to kindly take appropriate measures for admission in the Undergraduate programmes of your University."

The Standing Committee is of the Opinion that the Prospective students for the 5- year LL. B programme should have the special knowledge, analytic; reasoning aptitude in the legal field, in order to meet the objective of the National Education Policy for preparing the students who could compete globally, adopting best practices and embracing new technologies. The Committee observed that the CUET entrance exam conducted by the National Testing Agency, has a generic orientation and does not adequately test the aptitude of the students required for the Law courses. The UGC vide its letter dated 27.09.2023 has also not made mandatory for the Central Universities to take the students for professional gourses such as Engineering, Medical, Law through



CUET. The University of Delhi has been admitting the students for the professional courses from the merit list of specialized admission test viz, JEE, NEET etc.

The Standing Committee finds that the CLAT conducted by the consortium of NLU for LL.B admissions, is more geared towards adequately testing the students covering topics English Language, Current Affairs, General Knowledge, Legal Reasoning and quantitative Techniques. Majority of the prospective candidates aspiring for legal field after the 12th standard, compete through CLAT. Therefore, the Standing Committee recommends that for the Academic Session 2024-25 onwards the students for 5-year BBA-LL.B, BA/B. Com/LL.B be taken on the basis of the merit score of CLAT, applicable for the respective year.

Dean, Faculty of Law also informed the House that from the academic session 2024-25 onwards, PwBD, CW and Foreign Nationals candidates may be admitted under Supernumerary quotas (along with Orphans and Du employees ward quotas) as done for all undergraduate and postgraduate programs of University of Delhi

Apart from that with regard to Eligibility criteria for BALLB (Hons) and BBALLB (Hons) for the academic session 2024-25, it was resolved that it will be the same as it was of the Academic Session-2023.

1.5 Eligibility criteria and admission process of Post-Graduate Diploma in Cyber Security and Law (PGDCSL) for the academic session 2024-25.

The Committee unanimously resolved that the Eligibility criteria and admission process of Post-Graduate Diploma in Cyber Security and Law (PGDCSL) for the academic session 2024-25 will be the same as of the academic session-2023-24.

1.6 Admissions to M.Tech. Computer Science as proposed by Dean, Faculty of Mathematical Sciences.


After detailed deliberation on the issue, the Committee unanimously recommended that M.Tech. Computer Science as proposed by Faculty of Mathematical Sciences may start in the Department of Computer Science and admissions for the academic session-2024-25 may be done on the basis of GATE score. However, it was suggested that the program may be started only after the necessary approvals from AICTE before the commencement of the program (M.Tech. in Computer Science) in the Department of Computer Science, the department should have to take permission from the AICTE for the same.

1.7 Admissions to Master of Fine Art (MFA) in College of Art.

The Committee considered the request of Principal, College of Art to admit students to Master of Fine through CUET(PG).

In this regard, following were approved:

- 1. Minimum Eligibility: As per DU rules
- 2. Program-Specific Eligibility: Bachelor in Fine Art from a recognized University. The candidates applying for MFA must have passed BFA in the same relevant specialization.
- 3. CUET(PG) paper: HUQP03 (Applied Art)



HUQP07 - (Painting, Sculpture, Printmaking and Visual Communication)

Merit will be calculated by considering the combined 'CUET(PG) score (50% weightage) and Practical-Based Test score (50%weightage)'

1.8 Criteria for establishing similarity of CUET (UG) subjects with subjects studied in Class XII.

The committee unanimously resolved that for establishing similarity CUET(UG) subjects with subjects taken in class XII, at least 50% of reserves the right university The should match. syllabus establishing the similarity. The decision of University in this regard shall be final and binding.

2. REPORTING ITEMS

2.1 Recommendation of the committee constituted for filling the leftover vacancies in admission to Undergraduate programme to various College of the University of Delhi for the academic session 2023-24.

A meeting of the members of the committee was held on 25.09.2023 and following were recommended to be adopted under Special Spot Round:

- 2.1.1.1 Considering the interest of aspiring students and to optimize the total sanctioned strength of the college, it was recommended that Second Special Spot Round may be conducted as per the following process:
- 2.1.1.2 Only those Programmes in respective colleges wherein the number of vacant seats is more that 10% of the sanctioned strength of the programme will be shortlisted for admissions in Final Special Spot Round.
- 2.1.1.3 The University will display the vacant seats of each program, wherever applicable, of the shortlisted programmes.
- 2.1.1.4 Candidates who had applied for CSAS-2023 but are not admitted to any College on the date of declaration of the Final Special Spot Admission round can participate.
- 2.1.1.5 The admitted candidates will not be allowed to withdraw their admission.
- 2.1.1.6 The desirous candidate will be able to choose all programs in as many Colleges as he/she wishes to, subject to the availability of seats.
- 2.1.1.7 Two times extra allocation will be done in this round.
- 2.1.1.8 In Second Special Spot Round, allocations will be done based on the following criteria:
 - Availability of seats (i)
 - Program-Specific Merit (ii)
 - Order of Preference of College (Program + College) (iii)
 - (iv) Category
- 2.1.1.9 It will be mandatory for the candidate to take admission to the seat allocated in a Final Special Spot Round. Failure to accept the allocated seat in the Final Special Spot Admission round will forfeit the candidate's eligibility for admission to UoD.


The Committee noted the recommendations of the Committee constituted for filling the leftover vacancies in admission to Undergraduate programme to various College of the University of Delhi for the academic session 2023-24.



2.2 Mop-up admission round for admitting candidates in shortlisted Colleges and Programs.

Considering the recommendation stated by UGC in its letter no. DO. No. 22-8/2023(CU) dated 04.10.2023 and on the request of few candidates and Colleges, the University of Delhi conducted a Mop-up admission round for admitting candidates in the shortlisted colleges and programs only based on the following SOP:

- 2.2.1 Colleges in which more than 15% of the total sanctioned strength of the College are vacant may be considered for the Mop-up Admission Round.
- 2.2.2 In the Colleges identified in Point 1, Programs in which more than 10% of the sanctioned strength are vacant will be displayed by the University on its admission website (admission.uod.ac.in)
- 2.2.3 The University will display vacant seats for the shortlisted Programs/ Colleges for which Mop-up Admission Round can be held.
- 2.2.4 The shortlisted Colleges can admit candidates only in the Programs shortlisted by the University.
- 2.2.5 The Colleges may be allowed to admit the candidates directly only on the shortlisted programs. Steps stated in Point 6-16 to be adopted for admission for Mop-up round.
- 2.2.6 The concerned College will display the vacant seat matrix (UR, SC, ST, OBC, EWS) of its shortlisted Programs on the website of the College.
- 2.2.7 The College will develop a mechanism to invite applications only for the shortlisted programs.
- 2.2.8 There will be no registration fee for applying to the Mop-up Round.
- 2.2.9 The Colleges may ask for all relevant documents, as deemed appropriate from the candidates as the time of registration.
- 2.2.10 To fill the seats optimally, the Colleges may take recourse to the following:
 - a. CUET -2023 normalized scores as per Program-specific eligibility (published in the BOI(UG) 2023 and CSAS(UG)-2023) to form the merit.
 - b. In case the seats remain vacant after exhausting list of CUET-2023 applicants, College may admit candidates on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
- 2.2.11 Tie-breaking rules, if any, will be applicable as stated in CSAS (UG) 2023.
- 2.2.12 At the time of granting the admission, Colleges must check the minimum eligibility, Program Specific eligibility, Category documents and other aspects as stated in Bulletin of Information-UG (2023) and UG-CSAS-2023.
- 2.2.13 At the time of taking the admission an undertaking must be taken from the candidate that he/ she is not admitted in any other college of UoD as on date of admission.
- 2.2.14 If granting admission on the basis of qualifying marks, an undertaking must be taken from the candidate stating s(he) has either not appeared in CUET or was not eligible on the basis of CUET 2023 subjects.
- 2.2.15 The Colleges will develop a mechanism to take the admission fee from the selected candidates.
- 2.2.16 At the end of the Mop-up round, each College should send the details of candidates admitted in the Mop-up Round to the Admission Branch as per the format given below (in an excel sheet).





2.2.17 No admission shall be granted based on undertaking for extension of time for submitting the required documents.

2.2.18 No admission should be done on Supernumerary seats.

The Committee noted the Mop-up admission round for admitting candidates in shortlisted Colleges and Programs considering the recommendation stated by UGC in its letter no. DO. No. 22-8/2023(CU) dated 04.10.2023 and on the request of few candidates and Colleges of the University of Delhi

2.3 On the approval of Competent Authority, the Department of East Asian Studies, University of Delhi proposed admission to M.A. Chinese, M.A. Korean from the academic session 2023-24 based on the merit of the marks obtained in the Graduation level as per the Eligibility Criteria.

The admissions to M.A. Chinese, M.A. Korean from the academic session 2023-24 were based on the merit of the marks obtained in the Graduation level as per the Eligibility Criteria. Details of admissions were published in the Bulletin of Information: https://admission.uod.ac.in/userfiles/downloads/PG/190923PG-Merit-Based-2023.pdf

The Committee noted the admission to M.A. Chinese, M.A. Korean in the Department of East Asian Studies, University of Delhi for the academic a\session-2023-24.

2.4 On the approval of Competent Authority, the Faculty of Arts, University of Delhi proposed admission to M.A. Hindu Studies from the academic session 2023-24 based on the merit of the marks obtained in the Graduation level as per the Eligibility Criteria.

The admissions to MA Hindu Studies in the Faculty of Arts were based on the merit of the marks obtained in the Graduation level as per the Eligibility Criteria. Details of admissions were published in the Bulletin of Information: https://admission.uod.ac.in/userfiles/downloads/PG/190923PG-Merit-Based-2023.pdf

The Committee noted the admission to M.A. Hindu Studies in the Department, Faculty of Arts, University of Delhi for the academic a\session-2023-24.

2.5 The Executive Council of the University of Delhi in its meeting held on 25.08.2023 vide E.C. Resolution No. 1267 (27-1-12) resolved that the admissions to B.A. LL.B. (Hons) & B.B.A. LL.B. (Hons) programs at the University of Delhi will be based on the scores obtained in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2023.

Admissions to B.A. LL.B. (Hons) & B.B.A. LL.B. (Hons) programs at the University of Delhi conducted based on the eligibility criteria and seat matrix as approved in the Executive Council of the University of Delhi in its meeting held on 25.08.2023 vide E.C. Resolution No. 1267 (27-1-12). The allocation process was based on the scores obtained in CLAT 2023 as detailed in the Bulletin of Information published on the website: https://admission.uod.ac.in/userfiles/downloads/law/26092023_5-year-integrated-law-BOI-2023-2024.pdf

The Committee noted the admissions to B.A. LL.B. (Hons) & B.B.A. LL.B. (Hons) programs at the University of Delhi for the Academic Session-2023-24 as approved in the Executive Council of the University of Delhi in its meeting held on 25.08.2023 vide E.C. Resolution No. 1267 (27-1-12).



2.6 The Executive Council of the University of Delhi in its meeting held on 09.06.2023 vide E.C. Resolution No. 20 (20-15) resolved that three Colleges were granted approval by NCTE for offering ITEP w.c.f. the year 2023-24 namely (i) Shyama Prasad Mukherji College, (ii) Mata Sundri College and (iii) Jesus & Mary College. However, later, Dean, Faculty of Education informed that for the academic year 2023-24 the ITEP will be conducted in 2 Colleges namely (i) Shyama Prasad Mukherji College (BA-B.Ed. (Middle) and BA-B.Ed. (Secondary)) and Mata Sundri College (BA-B.Ed. (Secondary)).

Admissions to ITEP programs at the University of Delhi conducted based on the eligibility criteria and seat matrix as approved in the Executive Council of the University of Delhi in its meeting held on 09.06.2023 vide E.C. Resolution No. 20 (20-15). The allocation process was based on the scores obtained in NCET 2023-24 as detailed in the Bulletin of Information published on the website: https://admission.uod.ac.in/userfiles/downloads/UG/05102023_BOI%20ITEP%2020 23%2005.10.2023.pdf

The Committee noted, admissions to ITEP programs-2023 at the University of Delhi conducted based on the eligibility criteria and seat matrix as approved in the Executive Council of the University of Delhi in its meeting held on 09.06.2023 vide E.C. Resolution No. 20 (20-15).

2.7 Recommendation of the committee constituted by Executive Council vide Resolution No. 14-6 dated 09.06.2023 with regard to look into the provision for admission and other related matter including the minimum standard and procedure for award of Ph.D. category.

Two meetings of the constituted committee were held on 09.08.2023 and 14.11.2023 respectively.

Two meetings of the constituted committee were held on 09.08.2023 and 14.11.2023 respectively.

- **2.7.1** Following supernumerary seats were recommended for admission in Ph.D. for the academic year 2023-24:
 - (i) For teaching and non-teaching staff: upto 10% of total strength declared by the department
 - (ii) For PwBD candidates: 5% of total strength declared by the department
- 2.7.2 A supervisor can have one candidate from each of above mentioned supernumerary quota at a time. However, in a special case if a supervisor have to take more than one candidate from the above mentioned supernumerary quota, prior approval from the competent authority will be mandatory requirement.
- 2.7.3 For Phase II of PhD admission, in addition to the existing Important Points mentioned in the BOI, the following may be adopted:
 - (i) All candidates who had not applied for Phase I and are eligible (i.e., MPhil qualified, candidates who have qualified NTA's PhD Entrance Test) may be able to register afresh. Registration fees may be charged from the, as applicable.
 - (ii) All candidates who have registered in Phase I and wish to update their proposal may be allowed to do so without any additional fees.

The Committee noted the recommendation of the committee constituted by Executive Council vide Resolution No. 14-6 dated 09.06.2023 with regard to look into the provision

for admission and other related matter including the minimum standard and procedure for award of Ph.D. category.

3. Any other item with the permission of the Chair.

3.1 Admission process of NCWEB for the academic session 2024-25.

The Committee resolved that the admission process of NCWEB for the academic session 2024-25 will be the same as it was of academic session-2023-24.

3.2 Admission process of School of Open Learning (SOL) for the academic session 2024-25.

The Committee resolved that the admission process of SOL for the academic session 2024-25 will be the same as it was of academic session-2023-24.

3.3 Eligibility in B.A. Program Combinations.

It was resolved by the committee that the B.A. (Prog.) combination, where Mathematics/ Statistics/ Computer Applications/ Computer Science is one of the two core disciplines, it is mandatory that the candidate must have studied and passed Mathematics in Class XII examination. Similarly, wherever a Language is being offered as one of the two disciplines, the candidate must have a working knowledge of that Language.

4. The Committee considered the recommendations of the Medical Sciences Courses Admission Committee (MCAC) for admission to DM/M.Ch. (SS) Courses held on 21.07.2023 with regard to eligibility criteria, seat matrix and Bulletin of Information for admission to DM/M.Ch. (SS) Courses for the session 2023-2024 and resolved to approve the same.

The Committee authorized Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi to modify/ amend any of the recommendations/ decisions for Point 1.1 to 1.9, in the larger interest of the candidates.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

1.1 ADMISSION PROCEDURE: -

A. ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR COUNSELLING: The candidates are required to register themselves online on www.mee.nic.in (Medical Counselling Committee, DGHS, Government of India) to participate in Counselling for admission to Super -Speciality (DM/M.Ch) Courses - 2023.

Admissions (After successful allotment of Super-Speciality seats by MCC)

1. Only those candidates who are allotted seats in colleges affiliated to University of Delhi, after successful allotment of seats by the MCC, DGHS, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (Government of India) are required to register themselves on the online admission portal on the official website www.finsc.ac.in of Faculty of Medical Sciences through online link* for admission to Super -Speciality DM/M.Ch Courses after verification of their documents by the respective college.

The candidates are also required to complete the Registration by uploading their documents, photograph, signatures etc. and by making online payment of University Annual Fees of Rs. 25,900/-(Rupees Twenty Five thousand Nine Hundred only)*.

- 2. Before initiating the registration for admission, the candidates are advised to refer to Super-Speciality DM/M.Ch. Bulletin of Information 2023 thoroughly.
- 3. If any candidate, who has not been allotted any seat in University of Delhi or otherwise register for admission, somehow registers himself/herself on www.fmsc.ac.in, in such registration will be invalid and no fees will be refunded under any circumstances.
 - * The Fee mentioned above is under review and may change. Notice in this regard will be made available on the www.fmsc.ac.in.
- B. Admission process after successful allotment of seats by MCC, DGHS, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (Government of India):
 - (a) All the candidates seeking admission to the Super -Speciality courses are required to register online on website www.fmsc.ac.in.
 - (b) Online registration details for admission to Super Speciality courses are available on website www.fmsc.ac.in.
 - (c) As a first time user, candidate shall create the login details: -
- In the "Confirm your Information" webpage, candidate shall provide the NEET-SS-2023 Roll No. and Date of Birth. Clicking on "View" button will display further details of the candidate.

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- If the details are correct, candidate can click "Confirm" and proceed further.
- On the "New Registration" page, candidate has to enter a valid Mobile No. and Email ID which
 would be used for any future communication with the University for Admission Purpose.
- Candidate shall then create a password (of maximum six characters) for online registration purpose. This password does not need to be same as candidate's email account password, which is used to access one's email account.
- Candidate shall provide a valid mobile phone number (10-digit number without any prefix).
- Please verify that all the details given in the form are correct. This information will be used during
 the entire admission process. No change/modification is allowed. Please be careful in filling up
 the required information in all aspects.
 - (d) Applicant shall now log on by using "registered email-id" and created "password" to fill the online registration form.
 - (e) Applicant shall click "Save" and proceed to check the details filled in the form.
 - (f) The same login credentials should be used every time to login to the applicant's account.
 - (g) Applicant shall upload the following (wherever necessary):-

Note:- The candidates are required to bring Print out of Registration Form. Allotment letter and Original Certificates alongwith 92 sets of self attested photo copies of all the documents at the time of Admission.

Once all the above — mentioned files are uploaded, applicant can proceed with "Make Payment". Applicant can also update the uploaded files and application form using Back button before making payment. After payment is made no changes are applicable. In case a candidate does not meet the minimum eligibility criteria prescribed for applying to the concerned programme, it is done at the candidate's own risk and cost and if at any stage, it is found that the minimum eligibility requirements are not fulfilled, the admission, if granted, shall be cancelled ipso facto, and the fees paid, if any, shall not be refunded.

(h) Candidate's application submission process shall be complete only after payment of the online registration fees.

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After payment of the registration fee any corrections, additions, deletions etc. shall NOT be allowed. The candidates are, therefore, advised to fill their forms carefully after reading the instructions.

(1) Please note that the candidature is subject to the candidate's fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements prescribed for applying to the concerned programme of study.

1.2 REGISTRATION FEES AND 1st YEAR UNIVERSITY FEES:-

(a) Registration Fees (non-refundable):-

- The candidates shall submit the registration fees of Rs. 5,000/- alongwith the University fees (b) for the 1st year i.e. Rs. 25,900/-.
- Registration fee has to be paid during online registration process through online payment (c)
- It may be noted that the application submission process shall be completed only after payment (d) of the online registration fees.
- 2. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATE: -
- 2.1 The candidates, before filling in the form, should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for admission to the course. The candidates are required to go through the Bulletin of Information carefully and acquaint themselves with all requirements.
- 2.2 This Bulletin contains only brief extract of the ordinances, rules, and regulations of the University. The candidates should, therefore, acquaint themselves with the relevant ordinances, rules and regulations of the University regarding eligibility requirements, payment of fee, attendance, examination and other matters pertaining to their respective course.
- 2.3 The candidate should seek the information with regard to the- payment of salary, hostel and other facilities from the concerned College/Hospital/Institution.
- 2.4 The various terms & conditions mentioned in the Bulletin of Information (BOI) are subject to change made in the Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations by the University from time to time as per the decision of the Academic Council/Executive Council and also binding regulations/ directions of the National Medical Commission (NMC). The University reserves the right to amend the Ordinances, Rules and Regulations, at its discretion as and when considered necessary. In the event of any provision in the BOI being found to be at variance with any binding regulations/ directions of the National Medical Commission (NMC) then the higher norms will prevail.
- 2.5 The medium of teaching and examination for all the courses shall be in English.
- 2.6 Those candidates, who are not eligible, and have applied at their own risk and will not be entitled for admission if ineligibility of a candidate is detected at any stage their candidature/admission will be cancelled without any notice.
- 2.7 The candidate who is already pursuing any other Course must resign / relinquish the seat before completing the admission process.

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- 2.8 The candidates, who were offered a Super-Speciality (DM/ M.Ch) Courses seat in counselling during 2020, 2021 or 2022 (in case of Post-Graduate Degree) and during the year 2021 or 2022 (in case of Post Graduate Diploma) shall not be eligible for admission during the year 2023 in the following circumstances: -
- If a student surrenders seat in violation of IMCC rules/instructions, after joining the allotted institution.
- b. If the student leaves the courses before its completion.
- c. If the admission/registration of the student is cancelled/terminated by the University on account of unsatisfactory performance/misconduct/indiscipline.
- 2.9 In case of any dispute, the decision of the Medical Sciences Courses Admission Committee (MCAC) shall be final; however, an appeal may be filed with the Vice-Chancellor, University of Delhi against such decision.
- 2.10 After declaration of NEET-SS-2023, a candidate who is in service and is likely to get admission shall submit the NOC/Sanction of Study Leave/ Relieving letter from employer to join the course in college concerned by the stipulated date (as per MCC guidelines).

No candidate shall be allowed to join a course unless they have been relieved/sanctioned study leave from their employer.

- 2.11 The selected candidates will be required to undergo medical examination by a duly constituted medical board at the assigned institution, at their own cost, on the specified date. A candidate shall not be allowed to join the course, if found medically unfit for the course.
- 2.12 If any candidate, after receiving admission letter, does not report for medical examination and/or does not join the course on the specified dates, the admission shall be cancelled, fee forfeited and the bond will be enforced. The candidate who were not allowed to join the course being medically unfit, will be exempted and their fee etc. will be returned.
- 2.13 It is mandatory for a candidate admitted to any course to get registered with the Delhi Medical Council within one month of joining the course, failing which the admission shall be cancelled.
- 2.14 For all the legal matters, the jurisdiction will be National Capital Territory of Delhi only.
- 2.15 Candidate should preserve their NEET -SS-2023 admit card till the completion of admission process and produce the same at the time of admission and joining the course.
- SUPER- SPECIALITY (D.M/M.Ch.) COURSES:
- 3.1 Courses, Institutions, and Number of seats:
 - The Faculty of Medical Sciences offers Twelve (12) Super-Specialty Courses as per details available at www.mcc.nic.in and www.fmsc.ae.in.
- 3.2 The duration of Super-Speciality courses shall be three completed years including the period of examination.
- 3.3 Requirements for admission to Super-Speciality (DM/M.Ch.) Courses:
- 3.3.1 The candidate must have passed final MBBS examination and must have Completed satisfactorily one-year compulsory rotating internship.
- 3.3.2 The candidate must have full registration with the Delhi Medical Council/State Medical Council/National Medical Commission.
- 3.3.3 The candidate should be medically fit to pursue the allocated course on medical examination.
- Note: Candidates are advised to refer to the Builetin of Information of NEET-SS 2023 of NBE and MCC for further details.

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- Procedure for submission of application form for admission:

(vii) MD/MS/DNB Examination attempt Certificate.

(viii) Proof of writing thesis in case of candidate has passed DNB Course.

(ix) Employer's Certificate, if employed (proforma available at www.fmsc.ac.in).

(x) Self-attested copy of Admit Card of NEET-SS-2023

(xi) Self-attested copy of Score Card of NEET-SS-2023

- 3.4.2 The candidate, who has not passed qualifying examination (MD/ MS/DNB) at the time of submitting the application and is likely to pass the qualifying examination on or before the first counseling conducted by MCC must submit the self-attested copies of the certificates, failing which their candidature will not be considered.
- The candidate who is in-service should submit certificate from of his/her employer. 3.4.3
- 3.5 As soon as a candidate is allotted the sent by MCC, they are required to register themselves online at faculty website www.fmsc.ac.in and submit the 1" year Annual Fee of Rs. 25,900/through online payment gateway, after verification of their documents by the respective college.

3.5.1 Payment of Annual Tultion Fee by 2nd & 3rd year Super Speciality students:-

Important: -The tuition Fee amounting to its. 15,900/- (Twenty Five Thousand Nine Hundred only) is required to be paid by Super Speciality students for the 2nd year and 3nd year of the course by 16th August every year on the online fee portal of the University of Delhi as follows: https://fee.du.ac.in/index.php/site/login → STUDENTS LOGIN → Registered Email.

Thereafter, Rs. 1500/- per week fine will be charged as late free w.c.f. of 16th August of respective year onwards till the time students submit the fees. No relaxation in terms of late fee will be granted, if a candidate fails to submit the University fees on time.

- Note: (i) The students are advised to deposit the Annual Feet on the above mentioned designated fee portal of the University only. If any student deposits feet on any other feet portal, then no claim of refund will be entertained in any case.
 - (ii) The students are also advised to inform about any difficulty in depositing the Annual Fees to office of the faculty by sharing the screen shot of their login on the fee portal at pginsc@du.ac.in well in advance, to resolve the issue, if any.
- 3.6 Surety Bond: A bond worth Rs 10.00 lacs with two sureties must be executed by the candidates at the time of their admission. The admission will not be valid unless and until the Bond is executed by the candidates. The proforms of Bond is available on website www.fmsc.ac.in.

The students shall have to pay the Bond money of he 10.00 tacs to the Institution/University in the following circumstances: -

- a. If a student surrenders seat in violation of NICC rules/instructions, after joining the allotted institution.
- b. If the student leaves the courses before its completion.
- c. If the admission/registration of the student is cancelled/terminated by the University on account of unsatisfactory performance/misconduct/indiscipline.

3.7 Joining Report:

At the time of joining, the candidate would be required to submit the following in the assigned institution:

- (i) Joining Report: As per the prescribed format.
- (ii) Security Deposit: The candidate admitted to any of the courses is required to deposit Rs.10,000/-as Security Deposit in the respective College / Institute, which will be refunded on completion/leaving of the course.
- (iii) Enrolment Form: Issuance of Enrolment Number shall be through electronic mode only vide University letter no. Aca-II/Circular/Enrol. No./2016/03 dated 29.12.2016 of University of Delhi.
- 3.8 The provisional admission of a candidate would not be valid, if the candidate does not complete the above-mentioned requirements. After complying with the above-mentioned requirements of joining the course at the assigned institution, the joining report of the candidate is required to be submitted to the office of the Assistant Registrar, Faculty of Medical Sciences, through the Head of the Institution concerned certifying that all requirements have been complied with.

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3.8.1 Confirmation of Admission:

The admission of the candidate will be provisional.

The Head of the Department concerned after 4 months of the commencement of the course, but not later than 6 months of the said commencement, shall submit through the Head of the Institution, a report to the Board of Research Studies forMedical Sciences regarding performance of the candidate. The report should also confirm fulfillment of the requirements stipulated under Clause 3.6.1 & 3.6.2 of the Bulletin of Information. If the performance is stated to be satisfactory, his/her provisional admission shall be confirmed. If the performance is not found satisfactory or the requirement stipulated under Clause 3.6.1 & 3.6.2 of the Bulletin of Information are not fulfilled, the admission shall be cancelled and thecandidate will be informed about this within one month of the receipt of the report of the Head of the Institution.

- 3.9 The Super Speciality (DM/M.Ch.) courses are full time courses. No candidate shall be silowed to apply for/to join any other course or any other occupation, once he/she has been admitted in a course till the course is completed.
- 3.10. Any excess leave/period of absence has to be compensated by extension of training period. The student has to complete satisfactory training before becoming eligible for appearing in the examination.

- 3.11 The Super-Speciality student has to fulfill the requirement regarding thesis/publication of papers before being eligible for appearing in the examination. The examination will consist of theory and practical/clinical examination.

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- (a) The students admitted to DM/M.Ch. Course and who opted for the submission of thesis should submit 03 (Three) copies of thesis along with 03 copies of Protocols in the Faculty office by the due date (to be notified later on) and deposit the requisite thesis submission fees through online mode in the A/C details 10043545021, IFSC code SBIN0008778 a Bank Rs. 5,000/- in favour of Director, Delhi South Campus, towards the fees for evaluation of thesis. In case of M.Ch. CVTS/M.Ch. G.I. Surgery the letter of Acceptance for publication of Research papers from Journal Indexed in Medline and another in Journal published by Indian National Academic Societies/photocopy of printed article would be accepted as proof of fulfilling the criteria and the same should also be submitted in the Faculty office latest by the due date (to be notified later on).
- 4. Span Period: Student admitted to Super-Speciality Degree Course should pass the examination within 5 years from the date of registration to the course.
- 5. (Ordinance XV-B):-

Maintenance of discipline among Students of the University.

- 1. All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action are vested in the Vice-Chancellor.
- 2. The Vice-Chancellor may delegate all or such powers as he/she deems proper to the Proctor and to such other persons as he/she may specify in this behalf.
- 3. Without prejudice to the generality of power to enforce discipline under the Ordinance the following shall amount to acts of gross indiscipline:
 - a. Physical assault, or threat to use physical force, against any member of the teaching and nonteaching staff of any Institution / Department and against any student with in the University of Delhi
 - b. Carrying of, use of or threat to use of any weapons
 - c. Any violation of the provisions of the Civil Rights Protection Act, 1976
 - d. Violation of the status, dignity and honor of students belonging to the scheduled caste sand tribes
 - e. Any practice-whether verbal or otherwise -derogatory of women
 - f. Any attempt at bribing or corruption in any manner
 - g. Willful destruction of institutional property
 - h. Creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds
- i. Causing disruption in any manner of the academic functioning of the University system;
- J. Prohibition of Ragging as per Ordinance XV-C.

4. Without prejudice to the generality of his / her powers relating to the maintenanceof discipline and taking such action in the interest of maintaining discipline as mayseem to him/her appropriate, the Vice-Chancellor, may in the exercise of his / her powers aforesaid order or direct that any student or students—

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- a. be expelled; or
- b. be, for a stated period rusticated; or
- C. be not for a stated period, admitted to a programme or programmes of study in a College,
 Department or Institution of the University; or
- d. be fined with a sum of rupees that maybe specified; or
- e. be debarred from taking a university or College or Departmental Examination or Examinations for one or more years; or that the result of the student or studentsconcerned in the Examination or Examinations in which he/sheor they have appeared be cancelled.
- 5. Institutions, Halls and teaching in the concerned Departments. They may exercise their authority through, or delegate authority to such of the teachers in their Colleges, Institutions or Departments as they may specify for these purposes.
- 6. Without prejudice to the powers of the Vice-Chancellor and the Proctor as aforesaid, detailed rules of discipline and proper conduct shall be framed. These rules may be supplemented, where necessary, by the Principals of Colleges, Heads of Halls, Deans of Faculties and Heads of Teaching Departments in this University. Each studentshall be expected to provide himself / herself with a copy of these rules. At the timeof admission, every student shall be required to sign a declaration that on admission he/she submits himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Vice Chancellor and several authorities of the University who may be vested with theauthority to exercise discipline under the Acts, the Statutes, the Ordinances and the rules that have been framed the rein by the University.

6. ORDINANCE XV-C

Prohibition and Punishment for Ragging.

- Ragging in any for mis strictly prohibited, with in the premises of College/Department or Institution and any part of Delhi University system as well as on public transport.
- Any individual or collective actor practice of ragging constitutes gross indiscipline and shall be dealt with under this Ordinance.
- 3. Ragging for the purposes of this Ordinance, ordinarily means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power or status of senior students is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in any way considered junior or inferior by other students and includes individual or collective acts or practices which-
- (a) Involve physical assaulter threat to use of physical force;
- (b) violate the status, dignity and honor of women students;
- (c) violate the status, dignity and honor of students belonging to the scheduled castes andtribes;
- (d) Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem;
- (e) Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behavior.
- 4. The Principal of a College, the Head of the Department or an Institution, the authorities of College, of University Hostel or Halls of Residence shall take immediate action on anyinformation of the occurrence of ragging.

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- 5. Notwithstanding anything in Clause (4) above, the Proctor may also suomoto enquire into any incident of ragging and make a report to the Vice-Chancellor of the identity ofthosewho haveengaged inraggingandthenature of
- 6. The Proctor may also submit an initial report establishing the identity of the perpetrators of ragging and the nature of the ragging incident.
- 7. If the Principal of a College or Head of the Department or Institution or the Proctor issatisfied that for some reason, to be recorded in writing, it is not reasonably practical to hold such an enquiry, he/she may so advise the Vice-Chancellor accordingly.
- 8. When the Vice-Chancellor is satisfied that it is not expedient to hold such an enquiry, his/her decision shall be final.
- 9. On the receipt of a report under Clause (5) or (6) or a determination by the relevantauthority under Clause (7) disclosing the occurrence of ragging incidents described inClause 3(a), (b) and (c) the Vice-Chancellor shall direct or order rustication of a studentorstudentsfora specificnumber of years.
- 10. The Vice-Chancellor may in other cases of ragging order or direct that any student orstudents be expelled or be not for a stated period, admitted to a course of study in a college, departmental examination for one or more year so that the results of the student or students concerned in the examination or examinations in which they appeared be cancelled.
- 11. In case any students who have obtained degrees of Delhi University are found guiltyunder this Ordinance appropriate action under Statute 15 for withdrawal of degreesconferred by the University shall be initiated.
- For the purpose of this Ordinance, abetment to ragging whether by way of any act, practice or incitement of ragging will also amount to ragging.
- 13. All institutions with in the Delhi University system shall be obligated to carry out instructions/directions issued under this Ordinance, and to give aid and assistance to the Vice-Chancellor to achieve the effective implementation of the Ordinance.

Note: Order of the Vice-Chancellor in pursuance of Ordinance XV-C:

Where incident(s) of ragging are reported to the Vice-Chancellor by any authority underthis Ordinance, the students(s) involved in ragging, shall be expelled for a specified term, designated in the order. Non-students involved in reports of ragging will be proceeded with under the criminal law of India; they will also be rendered ineligible for a period offive years from seeking enrolment in any of the institutions of the University of Belhi. Students against whom necessary action is taken under this note, will be given post decisional hearing, with strict adherence to the rules of natural justice.

The Medical Council of India (presentation & prohibition of ragging in Medical Colleges/Institutions) regulations 2009 notified in the part III section 4 of the Gazette of India on 03.08.2009 amended from time to time be also adhered to.

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7. ORDINANCEXV-D

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013(MINISTRY OF LAW AND JUSTICE)

An Act to provide protection against sexual harassment of women at work place and for the prevention and redressal of complaints of sexual harassment and for matters connected the rewithin cidental thereto.

WHEREAS sexual harassment results in violation of the fundamental rights of a woman to equality under articles 14 and 15 of the Constitution of India and her right to life and to live withdignity under article 21 of the Constitution and right to practice any profession or to carry onany occupation, trade or business which includes a right to a safe environment free from sexualharassment;

AND WHEREAS the protection against sexual harassment and the right to work with dignity are universally recognized human rights by international conventions and instruments such as Convention on the Elimination of all forms of discrimination against Women, which has been attified on the 25th June, 1993 by the Government of India.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make provisions for giving effect to the said Convention for protection of women against sexual harassment at work place.
