


A. OBSERVATIONS:



2.	The NIHFW has the following full time faculty members:

(e)	Prof. Renu Shehrawat, Professor having more than 22 years teaching experience.
(f)	Prof. Nanthini Subbiah, Professor having more than 22 years teaching experience.
(g)	Dr. Meerambika Mahapatro, Professor having more than 12 years teaching experience.
(h)	Prof. Poonam Khattar, Professor having more than 16 years teaching experience
(i)	Prof. P. Swain, Professor having more than 24 years teaching experience
