Dr. Pranab Mukherjee

Dr. Pranab Mukherjee passed away on 31 August 2020.

He was Indian statesmen who sworn in as India's 13th president, with cross-party support that underlined his wide acceptability, an attribute rare in Indian politics. In 2012, Mukherjee resigned from parliament to take the largely figurehead role of head of state. He occupied several ministerial portfolios in the Government of India. Prior to his election as President, Mukherjee was Union Finance Minister from 2009 to 2012. "My passion has been the service of the people of India," Mukherjee said in a speech summing up 50 years in public life when he left the office of president in 2017. He was awarded India's highest civilian honour, the Bharat Ratna, in 2019, by the President of India. .

Prof. R. R. Singh

Prof. R. R. Singh passed away on 10th November 2020.

Prof. Singh, Department of Social Work, was an acclaimed social work educator, who was acknowledged both nationally and internationally for his significant contribution to social work education and practice. He played an instrumental role in establishing the Department of Social Work as a Pioneering institution for social work education in the country. Apart from being a very learned scholar and teacher, he was an avid practitioner, who played a key role in the implementation of the Community Development Programme in the 1950s. Prof. Singh was the Head of the Department from 03.07.1987 to 02.07.1990 and again from 01.08.1997 to 31.07.2000.

Prof. K. K. Mukhopadhyay

Prof. K. K. Mukhopadhyay passed away on 15th November, 2020.

Prof. Mukhopadhyay, Department of Social Work, was both, a well renowned social work educator and a much accomplished social work practitioner. A Gandhian at heart and in his life, he played a pioneering role in diffusing the spirit of Gandhian Social Work across the Country. He also served as the Director of Gandhi Bhawan, University of Delhi and played a proactive role in inspiring the entire University fraternity with the life and work of Gandhi.

Prof. M.K Julka

Prof. M. K. Julka passed away on 25th May, 2020.

He was a devoted professor of the German language and a regular face in the Department of Germanic and Romance Studies (GRS), the University of Delhi for more than 35 years. During his association with the University of Delhi, he also served as the Head of the Department for many years. He had close to five decades of rich bond with the German language, having the first PhD written in German in an Indian University to his credit. He also had several publications in International journals and had authored three books in German. He published articles in various magazines and translated many German books in English and Hindi.

Prof. D. N. Jha

Prof. D. N. Jha passed away on 04.02.2021.

A veritable giant in the field of Ancient Indian history, Dwijendra Naryan Jha was part of the Department of History for several decades (between 1975-2005) and played a vital role in its growth, contributing significantly towards its reputation for academic rigour. He invested a lot of his time

and scholarly effort towards the Indian History Congress- he was the Sectional President of Ancient India Section in 1979, General secretary in 1986 – 1989. In 1995 he was honoured by Indian History Congress with the prestigious H.K Barpujari award. He became the General President of the Indian History Congress in 2005-2006. His widely read textbook, Ancient India.

Prof. Sunil Kumar

Prof. Sunil Kumar passed away on 17.01.2021.

He was educated in the Universities of Delhi and Chicago and went on to complete his doctoral work on the emergence of the Delhi Sultanate at Duke University. He taught for over 35 years at the Department of History, University of Delhi, where he was Professor of Medieval History and the Head of Department. He has also held prestigious visiting professorships at the School of Oriental and African Studies, Institute for Near and Middle Eastern Studies, Ludwig Maximilian University, Munich, The University of California Berkeley, the Ecole Pratique des Hautes Etudes, Sorbonne, University of Paris, France, and Jawaharlal Nehru University, among other places.

Prof. R. L. Shukla

Prof. R. L. Shukla passed away on 17.10.2020.

Professor Shukla's career in the University of Delhi is parallel to the growth of the Department of History itself, he was an integral part of the Department in the critical period of the late seventies, eighties and nineties, right up to the new millennium. Professor Shukla retired in 2003, seventeen years back but it is a reflection on his persona that he still commands so much respect in the History Department and in colleges across the University. Professor Shukla's tenure in the Department of History was noteworthy for his dedication and unflinching ideological principles.

Prof. P. C. Jain

Prof. P. C. Jain passed away on 28th April, 2020.

Prof. P. C. Jain did his M.Sc., in Physics from University of Delhi around 1958. After earning his Ph.D. degree from DU, he joined a DU college as a lecturer. Later, he joined the faculty of the Dept. of Physics and Astrophysics, DU Professor Jain also worked in some of the well-known university laboratories abroad. He published a number of high-quality research papers.

Prof. S. Duraiswami

Prof. S. Duraiswami passed away on 05th October, 2020.

Prof. Duraiswamy was a scholar par excellence, eminent biochemist, marvelous teacher and a towering statesman in the Department of Zoology. He was admired by students and colleagues for his teaching and deep knowledge in the discipline. After completion of post graduation on and PhD from IISc bangalore, he again joined the Phd program in University of Wisconsin. After the award of 2nd PhD degree, he taught for a short period in IISc and then in the University of Wisconsin (1960-1964).

Prof. Dr. Bhim Sen Kapoor

Prof. Dr. Bhim Sen Kapoor passed away on 17th January, 2021.

He Joined Department of Chemistry, University of Delhi in the year 1955 as a graduate student. He did his Ph.D. under the guidance of Prof. RP Mitra. Joined the department as a Lecturer (Physical Chemistry) in 1966 and retired in February 2004. His area of specialization was Soil Chemistry. He guided several M.Phil and PhD students. He published several research appears in national as well

as International journals. He was a man of principles & extraordinary determination. His numerous students will remember him as a methodical and inspiring teacher.

Prof. Vinay Kumar Srivastava

Prof. Vinay Kumar Srivastava passed away on 23rd December, 2020.

Vinay Kumar Srivastava, was a distinguished Professor of Anthropology, who joined the University in 1976 as lecturer in the Hindus college and superannuated on December 31, 2017. A teacher par excellence, Professor Srivastava, was also the former Head of Anthropology Department and Principal of the Hindu College. A prolific researcher, he has to his credit more than 300 research papers published from National and International Journals. He has also authored 12 books from reputed publishers like Sage and the Oxford University Press, other than guiding 23 PhD theses.

Prof. H. K. Kumbnani

Prof. H. K. Kumbnani passed away on 24th November, 2019.

He was a professor in the Department of Anthropology, University of Delhi. After his post-graduation, he joined the National Institute of Nutrition under Dr. Gopalan. He continued in this position till March 1964. He then joined the Anthropological Survey of India (An.S.I.) on a senior fellowship and was affiliated to the Department of Anthropology, University of Delhi, to work under Professor P. C. Biswas. His research work was also in the field of Human Cytogenetics. Besides Munster, He was a very serious researcher and a hard taskmaster with the students. His publications, appearing in journals of international repute, relate to palmar mainline and transversality.

Prof. Wali Akhtar

Prof. Wali Akhtar passed away on 09th June, 2020.

Prof. Wali Akhtar was a Senior Professor of Arabic language and literature in Department of Arabic, University of Delhi. He was a great Scholar of world fame. He was a good teacher and a great writer. He wrote more than 20 articles and about six books in Arabic, most of them are course books.

ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE YEAR

Brief overview of the numerous achievements of the year 2019-2020 (April 1, 2019 – March 31, 2020) are presented here.

FOUNDATION DAY

The University of Delhi has celebrated its 97th Foundation Day on May 1. The distinguished guests, who are also eminent alumni of the University including Hon'ble Ms. Justice Gita Mittal, Chief Justice, High Court of Jammu & Kashmir; Ms. Pinky Anand, Additional Solicitor General of India; Dr. Harsha Vardhana Singh, Former Deputy Director General, WTO; Shri Madhup Vyas, IAS, Secretary (Power), Delhi Government; Shri Ramji Srinivasan, Senior Advocate, Supreme Court of India; Shri Aman Sinha, Senior Advocate, Supreme Court of India. The University of Delhi has been conferring various categories of awards on its Foundation Day and this year also, the University conferred upon highly deserving individuals who have rendered exemplary service to the University. The awards include Distinguished Service Awards for Retired Teachers (awarded to Prof. Anil K. Tyagi), Excellence Awards for Teachers in Service (awarded to Dr. Surjit Sarkar, Dr. Pramod Kumar Singh, Dr. Sumanjeet Singh, Dr. Mala Kapoor Shankardass and Dr. N Latha) and Award of Appreciation (awarded to Prof. Maharaj K. Pandit).

CONVOCATION

The University organized its 96th Annual Convocation on November 4, 2019. The University was privileged to welcome Hon'ble Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu, Vice President of India as Chief Guest. The Hon'ble Minister of Cabinet, Human Resource and Development, Government of India, Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal "Nishank" was the Guest of Honour.

Degrees were conferred upon 597 Ph.D. candidates and 86 D.M. /M.Ch. candidates. More than 305 medals and prizes were awarded to the meritorious students.

RANKINGS OF THE UNIVERSITY

The University has maintained its position at the top in the country as per the Centre for World University Ranking (CWUR) and 11th position in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF). The University of Delhi is also among the top 10 Indian public educational institutions/universities and the first among Indian public universities under QS BRICS University Rankings.

The University of Delhi has been ranked as 501-510 in the QS World University Rankings 2021. The University of Delhi has been ranked as 601-800 in the Times Higher Education (THE) World University Ranking 2021, 155th in THE Asia University Rankings 2020 and 147th in The Emerging Economics University Rankings 2020.

INSTITUTION OF EMINENCE

The University of Delhi was recognized as an Institution of Eminence (IoE) by the Ministry of Education (MoE) (earlier Ministry of Human Resource Development), Government of India, vide its communication dated 04-09-2019. Based on the MoU signed between the University of Delhi and the MoE on 27.02.2020, the MoE issued a notification on 02.03.2020 declaring the University of Delhi as an "Institution of Eminence". NAAC ACCREDITATION

In 2018 the University of Delhi was accredited with 'A+' grade with a CGPA of 3.28 in the NAAC assessment conducted as per the revised framework.

EXAMINATIONS

In 2019, the Computer-based Entrance examination was conducted by the National Test Agency in partnership with the University of Delhi at 18 cities across the country including Delhi. Live-CCTV surveillance along with technical devices was undertaken to ensure fairness of entrance examinations.

EQUALITY AND MODERNIZATION IN DISTANCE LEARNING

Online admissions were conducted for all undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in SOL & NCWEB. The University of Delhi is one of the first three Universities which has received Letter of Intent for offering five undergraduate programmes through Online mode from January 2020 session.

To ensure fairness, transparency and efficiency in admissions, the University has adopted and implemented policies towards streamlining the student-friendly, glitch-free, online, a centralized online admission process for undergraduate, postgraduate, M.Phil. and Ph.D. since 2016 based on the theme "Go-Green, Go-Digital and Minimum Human intervention".

ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL PROCESS

Various online systems are in place to ensure transparency and commitment to implement policy of "Zero Tolerance against Corruption" in all processes including Student Grievance Redressal System; Hostel Accommodation; Central Placement Cell for Students and Companies; Scholarship Disbursement; House Allotment; Bill processing and Tracking; E- Procurement and GeM; Online Fees Collection Portal; Initiation of Samarth ERP for DU

LIBRARY SYSTEM

Besides improving e-ShodhSindhu, J-Gate@e-ShodhSindhu, Internet Access Facility and Electronic Databases, the following digital initiatives are introduced in the DU library system: Accessible resources for Visually Impaired; Digital Collection of Ph.D. theses; Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) - TURNITIN; URKUND through INFLIBNET.

CAMPUS CONNECT PROJECT AND VALUE-ADDED SERVICES

The University has signed an MoU with MoE (MHRD), UGC and NICS for establishment of campus-wide Wi-Fi network. This project would augment the existing Wi-Fi connectivity in more

than 150 departments/academic units/ centers and administrative units and about 20 hostels with concurrent user base of approximately 30,000. Various initiatives are in place including: Expanding Wi-Fi infrastructure across the campuses; Redesigned campus topology in Ring architecture; Robust Identity Management; Wi-Fi Roaming facility; VPN Facility for Faculty members to access e-Resources from home / anywhere.

LECTURE SERIES

The following lectures were organized:

Special Lecture Samvad - His Excellency Shri Michael Ashwin Satyendra Adhin, Vice-President of Suriname on Vedic Science, Law and the Society, September 19, 2019.

Ambassadorial Lecture Series - His Excellency Walter J. Lindner, the Ambassador of Federal Republic of Germany to India, September 25, 2019.

The First Arun Jaitley Memorial Lecture: A lecture series has been instituted by the University of Delhi in the memory of its eminent alumnus, Late Shri Arun Jaitley, former Finance Minister of India. The First Arun Jaitley Memorial Lecture was delivered by Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu, Hon'ble Vice President of India, on Tuesday, October 29, 2019.

Cultural Flavours of India Series, Meeras-e-Kashmir: The University of Delhi organised the first chapter of a series of cultural events, "Meeras-e- Kashmir" under the banner of "Cultural Flavours of India" showcasing the diverse cultural heritage of India on February 18, 2020.

RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

The h-index of the University touched 192, one of the highest among the Indian universities.

Number of the Departments with Financial Assistance under various schemes of UGC (SAP) for the year 2019-20: Departmental Research Support (DRS) – 05; Department of Special Assistance (DSA) – 01; Centre for Advanced Study (CAS) – 09.

Faculty Members with Grants above Rupees One Crore: During the reporting period, more than 15 faculty members have Ongoing Research Projects of the value of more than Rupees One Crore each.

Faculty Members with Grants above Rupees Ten Lakhs: More than 200 Faculty Members have ongoing projects with grants above Rupees Ten Lakhs each.

ELECTROPRENEUR PARK AND INCUBATION CENTRES AT THE UNIVERSITY

Electropreneur Park: Recent on-boarded start-up under incubation at Electropreneur Park in 2019-20 includes: Developing a low cost IoT Based Mopping Robot; Creating AI enabled unmanned aircraft system solutions; Creating refilling vending machines to save plastic wastage; Developing IOT based agricultural storage management system; Developing a portable E-Moped.

Design Innovation Centre (DIC) at University of Delhi with funding from the Ministry of Education (formerly MHRD): In the year 2019-20, various online courses were offered by DIC, including "Design Innovation and Startup," "Design Thinking," "2D & 3D Product Designing," "Branding Basics." DIC has also conducted various workshops, including "SOLIDWORKS," and "Internet of Things." Various innovative products are in the final stage at the DIC, including "Indian Paper Puppets DIY Kit," "Automated Drones," "Spy Cam with Mobile Charger," "Smart Street Light," "Anti-camera reflective frame."

IPR Cell and Patent Fund

The University has guidelines for patent filing and collaborative research. A patent fund was set up for the University faculties. During the year 2019-20, two patents were granted and six patent applications were published.

FACULTY AWARDS/HONOURS

More than seventy (70) faculty members have been awarded with various prestigious National/International awards.

SEMINARS/CONFERENCES/WORKSHOPS ORGANISED

More than eight (80) seminars/conferences/workshops were conducted at National/International level by various Departments of the University.

MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING WITH FOREIGN UNIVERSITIES

To enrich its academic inputs and experiences, the University of Delhi has maintained its tradition of entering into academic collaboration with premier institutions. In the reporting period, MoUs and Agreements were established with about eighteen (18) Universities.

SOCIAL OUTREACH

The University of Delhi is an active participant in the "plastic-free-village" campaign in its five adopted villages of Jharoda, Jagatpur, Mukudpur, Badarpur Khadar and Chauhan Patti. This ongoing engagement is an integral part of the commitment of the University of Delhi to evolve as a "University beyond Campus" and one that is alive to the critical social realities of our times.

PLACEMENT ACTIVITIES

The Central Placement Cell (CPC) of University of Delhi comes within the purview of DSW Office and organises various Internship and capacity building/skill enhancement programmes for undergraduate and Post graduate students. It is also a platform to facilitate students from different colleges and streams to get recruitment opportunities in the illustrious industries across the world.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CELL INITIATIVES

Committed to the vision of an inclusive University and the mission of empowering Persons with Disabilities, the Equal Opportunity Cell of the University has continued to endeavor towards the improvement of various facilities for such students. Some of its salient activities include: Volunteer Support; Conversion of reading materials in accessible format; Admissions; Limited transport facility; Centre of Disability Studies; KEBO Camera-Scanner.

RTI Wing

In consonance with the spirit of the Act, the University has been actively disclosing information pertaining to all the arenas of its functioning for the information of its stakeholders, which include the employees, students, alumni and prospective students and employees. During the year 2019-20, the volume of original applications received by the University is almost the same as received by nodal Ministries like MHRD. During the year as many as 2851 original applications were received, 454 First Appeals were heard and 48 Second Appeal hearings were attended.


