2. REHEARSAL

There will be a rehearsal on Friday, the **25th February**, **2022 at 2.30 P.M.** in the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007 to familiarize the participants.

The recipients of the Medals and Prizes must attend the rehearsal. They must follow the instructions and remain in their seats in the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex till the rehearsal is announced to be over.

3. SEATING ARRANGEMENT IN THE MULTIPURPOSE HALL, DELHI UNIVERSITY SPORTS STADIUM COMPLEX

All the recipients of Medals & Prizes will be allotted a seat. A list showing the allotted seat numbers will be displayed outside the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex. Candidate should report latest by **9.30 A.M.**

4. CONVOCATION DRESS

The men graduates should appear in high-buttoned up coats with Trousers (National Dress) and Women graduates should wear White Sarees with Blouse or White Shirt (Kurtas) with Salwar or Chooridar Pajamas.

4. <u>ACADEMIC COSTUMES</u>

Candidates should appear in academic costume in the Convocation. Candidates can contact the following to hire the Academic Costumes (Gown and Hood) for the Convocation. Students can get the academic costume from **Department of Environmental Studies** or any other nearby designated place in the North Campus.

5. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS/SAFETY MEASURES IN VIEW OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC

The Candidates are advised to adhere to the following to maintain the sanctity and tradition of the Convocation Ceremony:

- i) Mandatory use of face covers/masks, hand sanitizer and hand gloves.
- i) Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed.
- ii) Installation of Aarogya Setu App in mobile phones is mandatory.
- iv) No request for receiving the medal/prize "in Person" shall be entertained once the final roll call is over.

- x) No food and drinking items will be allowed inside the Venue.
- xi) Use of Delhi Metro Rail for commuting should be preferred as parking facility is very limited.
