# Rules @ On-the-Spot Photography Competition

## 1. Eligibility

- 1.1. The competition is **open to all**. No restriction on number of participants from an institute.
- 1.2. A participant can participate only under either of the two categories mentioned above and is required to submit only ONE image for the contest.
- 1.3. The photograph must have been taken by the participant on the date of event and at the venue.

## 2. Technical Requirements: File size: $\geq 2$ MB, File type: jpeg/jpg, Resolution: At least 4 Megapixels

- **Post Processing:** All the photographs in jpg format. Basic editing like colour enhancement, simple lighting, contrast and cropping is allowed. Advanced editing and/or manipulations, digital composition in images is prohibited.

## 3. Registration and Submission: on the registration desk

Participants registering under category 'Delhi University Community' must show a valid ID card issued by college/department/competent authority of University of Delhi, and participants under 'open category' may show any valid photo ID card. Only one image of specified technical requirements may be submitted in a pen drive. Kindly note: Organizers will not arrange pen drive for the submission. Also, organizers will not provide laptop for selection/editing of image/s. Late entries will not be accepted.

### Before submission participants should take care on following points:

- The file name for submitted image must be the full name of participant.
- Submitted photograph must not have any kind of watermark/signature/logo/copyright mark etc.
- Participants should provide following details in Word doc/pdf along with image:
  - i. Details of camera/device used for photography
  - ii. Caption/ brief description of photograph reflecting essence of the theme (in about 30 words)

## 4. Copyright/Intellectual Property

- 4.1. The participant shall retain copyright to the image entered for the competition.
- 4.2. By submitting an image for the competition, the participant will be regarded as having granted the organizer the right to use the image in print, broadcast and/or electronic media without any fee payment, for the purposes of promoting the competition or areas related to the organizer's work. including urban planning and design, conservation, architecture etc. Where any image is so used by the organizer, the participant will be acknowledged accordingly.

## 5. Judging and Results

- 5.1. The photographs will be evaluated by a panel of judges and their decision will be final.
- 5.2. The organizers reserve the right to reject photographs that do not meet technical specifications, late entries, multiple submissions/entries, plagiarized and manipulated images.
- 5.3. No correspondence pertaining to the evaluation process and decision will be entertained.
- 5.4. The judging panel and organizers reserve the right not to award any prize.

## 6. Prizes

- 6.1. Results of the competition will be declared on the day of the Flower show or may be later. The winners may be informed by email/telephonically. Awarded/selected photographs may be displayed on Delhi University Gardens website.
