A meeting of the Inspection Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, University of Delhi in terms of Statute 30(1)(c)(iii) of the Statutes of the University was held on Tuesday, 13th August, 2024 at 10:00 am in the office of the Director, Lady Hardinge Medical College, New Delhi to re-access the availability of infrastructure, equipment, teaching faculty, library, laboratories, etc. for increasing intake of 7 to 9 seats in MD (Psychiatry) Course at LHMC.



The Director, Lady Hardinge Medical College (LHMC) welcomed the members and thereafter meeting was held in the Committee Room of the LHMC.

A brief presentation was made by Prof. Prema Kukreti, Professor, Department of Psychiatry, LHMC regarding increasing an intake of 7 to 9 seats per academic year in MD (Psychiatry) as per the availability of equipment's, workload, involvement in teaching programme, faculty members, resident doctors' technical staff and future plan of the Department etc.

The Committee inspected the various wings of the Department of Psychiatry, Lady Hardinge Medical College, to ascertain the availability of teaching faculty/infrastructure, equipment, bed strength, OPD/IPD, Library/Journals, and Laboratories etc. for increasing an intake of 7 to 9 seats in MD (Psychiatry).

A. The observations of the Inspection Committee:

1.	Lady Hardinge Medical College is presently imparting UG (MBBS), PG(MD/MS) DM(Neonatology) & M.Ch. Paediatric Surgery) and Ph.D Courses.
2.	The Department of Psychiatry has the following full time faculty members: -
(a)	Prof. Dinesh Kataria, Professor having more than 21 years & 11 months teaching experience and more than 36 publications.
(b)	Prof. Om Sai Ramesh V. Professor having more than 23 years & 08 months teaching experience and more than 26 publications.
(c)	Prof. Shiv Prasad, Professor having more than 13 years & 06 months teaching experience and more than 15 publications.
(d)	Prof. Sumit Rana, Professor having more than 12 years & 02 months teaching experience and 14 publications.
(e)	Prof. Prerna Kukreti, Professor having more than 11 years & 10 months teaching experience and 68 publications.
(f)	Dr. Bhavuk Garg, Associate Professor having more than 09 years & 05 months teaching experience and 12 publications.
(g)	There are six Senior Residents in the Department of Psychiatry, LHMC.
3.	It was observed that the Department of Psychiatry fulfills the required conditions of teaching faculty as per norms of the National Medical Commission (NMC).

B. The Clinical facilities available in the Department of Psychiatry:

- Provides services for Psychiatry in Out-patient and indoor-patient form.
- 60 dedicated beds for the Department of Psychiatry, including 2 units of 30 beds each.
- The available infrastructure is sufficient to fulfill the demand of having MD seats per year.
- The total OPD census for one year was 32914. The IPD for the same period was 423.
- Adequate staff (nurses, technicians, orderlies, clerical, sanitation workers).

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
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
C. Recommendations
