I. Objective of the Programme

The programme is a step in globalising the principle of *Vasudhaiv Kutumbakam* in the field of Academic Administration. The world of higher education is opening up fast with growing interaction and collaboration among seats of learning. Moving beyond regional and national boundaries, there is an increasing emphasis on sharing of knowledge to seek solutions for problems that affect the entire humanity. Academic Administrators being the backbone of educational institutions would be required to act as active collaborators and facilitators for the same.

The programme seeks to upgrade the skills of our Academic Administrators so that they can be active players in making India a developed nation by 2047 and actualizing the dream vision of our Hon'ble Prime Minister, "*Viksit Bharat@2047*".

After the success of our collaboration with London School of Economics & Political Science and University of Liverpool, this is our third venture in imparting training to the Academic Administrators of India at a global level.

Key features of the programme:

1. Reflect on professional practice to identify key opportunities and challenges in advancing internationalisation, innovative teaching, and institutional management within Indian higher education.
2. Examine policy frameworks and global trends in higher education, including quality measures (e.g. ranking systems), employability and careers support, and emerging pedagogic approaches, while evaluating their practical application in diverse institutional contexts.
3. Strengthen leadership and administrative capabilities by engaging with best practices in governance, resource management, and academic development, recognising strategies that enhance institutional effectiveness and sustainability.

4. Explore innovation in teaching, research, and administration through exposure to pioneering pedagogies, centres of excellence, and innovation initiatives, while critically reflecting on their transferability and potential for transformational practice
5. Foster global perspectives and cultural understanding by examining UK higher education structures, application processes, and course offerings, deepening awareness of cross-cultural academic practices.
6. Engage collaboratively with peers and UK faculty/administrators to exchange ideas and nurture opportunities for co-developed pathways for student mobility, joint research, dual curricula and faculty exchange, and demonstrate the capacity to cascade learning within home institutions.

III. Participation Fee

(this would include Visa Fee, travel insurance and Air Travel expenses)

IV. Process of Registration

- The Registration process for the programme will begin on 22 December, 2025. The last date for registration shall be 30 January 2026.
- Interested administrators/faculty members from various institutions including colleges affiliated to the University of Delhi may apply at the earliest. In case, the number of registered participants is more than the available seats, the University reserves the right to shortlist the final list of participants.
- The participants can register with a nomination letter from the sponsoring institution. Format for sponsorship letter is appended at the end of this brochure. The interested applicants should ensure that the sponsorship letter for their participation is in the prescribed format.
- The sponsoring institution will have to transfer the participation fee of Rs. 5,50,000 within 05 working days of applying for the registration by the sponsored participant. The registration fee shall be refunded in case the registered participant is not included in the final list.
- The participation fees of Rs. 5,50,000 is required to be paid through online mode to the University of Delhi account as per details given below:
