### 2. MODE OF SELECTION:

- a. The selection shall be made through a **Walk-in-Interview**.
- b. SC, ST, OBC, EWS, Ex-SM and PwD candidates, who are selected on their own merit without relaxed standards, will not be adjusted against the reserved vacancies. Such candidates will be accommodated against the general/unreserved vacancies for the post as per their position in the overall merit. The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst the eligible SC, ST, OBC, EWS, Ex-SM and PwD candidates.
- c. **A person with disability who is selected on his/her own merit can be appointed against an unreserved vacancy provided the post is identified suitable for Persons with Disability of the relevant category.**
- d. Provisional nomination/selection in the examination confers no right of appointment unless the Appointing Authority is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the service/post.
- e. **The candidates not having essential qualification as exactly mentioned in the Recruitment Rules of the concerned post need not apply.**

### 3. RESERVATIONBENEFITS:
