It was brought to the notice of the Committee that the University is receiving several requests from students, colleges and departments for re-admission where students discontinued their studies prior to final semester/year.

The matter was deliberated at length and considering significant interest of students and the transition from the CBCS to the NEP curriculum, the Standing Committee recommended that re-admission of students who discontinued their studies prior to the final semester/year may be allowed. The re-admission shall be granted to the semester in which the student last studied at the respective college/department, subject to fulfillment of conditions specified by the University (e.g., fee payment, verification of records, eligibility checks etc).

Further, it was resolved that the Principal of the respective College may devise a mechanism to facilitate such students in terms of classroom teaching, attendance and internal assessment, if any.
