Thereafter, the Minutes of the meeting of the Executive Council held on 18.03.2021 (**Appendix-I**) were confirmed with the above amendments.

**5/-** The Action Taken Report on the decisions made by the Executive Council at its meeting held on 31.08.2021 (**Appendix-II**) were noted.

**7/-** The recommendation of the Selection Committee dated 17.08.2021 regarding promotion of Dr. Amita Gupta, Department of Biochemistry, Associate Professor to that of Professor was placed before the Executive Council for consideration. The Executive Council noted that the Selection Committee did not recommend promotion of the candidate.

A representation dated 19.08.2021 received from the candidate citing her credentials of publication, research work, project etc. was also placed before the Executive Council.

The Executive Council after deliberations and perusal of the two documents observed that prima-facie, the reasons recorded by the Selection Committee vis-à-vis the representation of Dr. Amita Gupta is at variance.

Taking a holistic view in the matter, the Executive Council resolved to set-aside the recommendation of the Selection Committee and authorised the Vice Chancellor to constitute a fresh Selection Committee to reassess the candidate and take decision accordingly.

**8/-** The Executive Council approved the following recommendations made by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 24.08.2021. The Executive Council has also recommended that the consequential amendments to the relevant Ordinance of the University be made accordingly:

8-1/ The Council resolved and accepted the following recommendations of the Standing Committee on Academic Matters made at its meeting held on 23.08.2021.

8-1-1/ Recommendations of the Committee for implementing National Education Policy 2020 (NEP) as under:

1. The NEP 2020 should be implemented in the University from the Academic Year 2022-23.
2. The structure of Under-Graduate Programmes recommended by the NEP Implementation Committee (**Appendix-III**) were accepted. Shuffling of papers across semester(s) within the structure can be done with the approval of the Academic Council.
3. (a) The quality of the degree conferred by the University should not be compromised. Accordingly, the existing structure and workload should continue along with addition of various courses under Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Value Addition Courses (VAC) etc. so as to make it holistic and multidisciplinary in line with UGC letter No. D.No. F.2-8/2021 dated 22.07.2021 (**Appendix-IV**).
- (b) To infuse holistic and multidisciplinary education while maintaining the quality of education, the number of credits determined by the NEP Implementation Committee for each academic level (Levels 5, 6, 7 and 8) was recommended to be adopted. Further, it was noted that it would not only be amenable to the existing framework but also imbibe the spirit of NEP 2020 to develop competent and well-rounded individuals.
- (c) The various additional courses proposed by the NEP Implementation Committee, such as Language and Literature, Social and Emotional Learning, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Co-curricular, Ethics and Culture, IT Skills, Data Analysis and Mathematics, Science and Society, etc. as well as the existing courses which will continue to run, shall be framed/revised in tune with the spirit of NEP 2020 so as to enable their implementation in 2022-23.
- (d) The steps taken in the direction to lay the foundation of holistic and multidisciplinary education in higher education shall be communicated to the UGC once the concrete framework of these courses shall be designed.

4. The Multiple entry and Exit Scheme (MEES) and Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) shall be implemented in the University, keeping in view the maintenance of standard of education by emphasizing on the core courses in the University and allowing the credits to be earned from other universities with respect to other courses. It was also decided that the detailed modalities need to be worked out for rolling out the MEES and ABC. The details of the same shall be worked out separately in line with UGC letter No. D.No. F.2-8/2021 (IoE-NEP) dated 19.07.2021 (**Appendix-V**).
5. The University shall retain the 3 years Honours Degree as well as well as assimilate in its structure the 4 years Honours Degree and 4 years Honours Degree with Research.
6. The University to implement both one year and two years Post-Graduate Programme in line with the existing structure and that of NEP 2020.
7. The Committee recommends the following for lateral entry / re-entry of students:
  - a) For students of other Universities registered under Academic Bank Credit system, lateral entry of eligible students be allowed into the University after conducting entrance test;
  - b) The seats for lateral entry may be worked out on the basis of the academic and infrastructural facilities available keeping in view the relevant norms, such as student-teacher ratio, teaching-non-teaching staff ratio, laboratory, library, teaching learning tools, etc.
  - c) For students of the University of Delhi and its Colleges, re-entry may be allowed.
8. The inclusion of NCC course as General Elective Credit Course at UG level be taken into consideration while formulating the detailed course structure in line with UGC letters No. D.O. No. 1-18/2019 (CPP-II) dated 18.04.2021 & 09.07.2021 (**Appendix-VI**).
9. The existing M.Phil. Programme to be discontinued from the academic year 2022-23 in line with the NEP 2020.

The ASO-CU-Cdn, MoE vide email dated 22.06.2021 forwarded the letter No.F.No.19-52/2017-CU/CDN dated 21.06.2021 of MoE alongwith a template of MoU (Tri- partite to be signed amongst the Central Universities, MoE and UGC) with specified Performance Parameters (**Appendix-XXIV**).

**12/-** The Executive Council considered and approved the request of Director, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Centre for Biomedical Research (ACBR) for immediate appointment utilizing the panel of wait list recommended by the duly constituted Selection Committee against the post of Assistant Professor (Advt. No. Estab.IV/278/2019 dated 02.07.2019), following due reservation roster policy of Government of India / UGC / University, as soon as the approval from the UGC is received.

**Note:** Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Centre for Biomedical Research (ACBR) is running a core paper on Toxicology & Pharmacology in III Semester as well as a special paper on Advance toxicology in IV Semester. These two courses are very important with respect to Biomedical Sciences at ACBR. Running these courses requires additional posts of Assistant Professor.

In this connection it is pertinent to mention that although ACBR has several posts of Professors lying vacant, it is difficult to find candidates for the same. Several faculty members appointed as Assistant Professor and / or Readers / Associate Professor have been promoted as Professor. The ACBR has more number of Professors now and the number of Assistant Professor is negligible. Therefore, looking at our earnest requirement, University has requested the UGC to convert the Post of two Professors to two Assistant Professors. The matter is under consideration with UGC for approval.

The University may levy compensation for authorized occupation of University accommodation beyond the permissible period after superannuation to the Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff who has been engaged on contract basis by the University as per the requirement of the University from Type-I to Type-III accommodation as 20 times of the License fees per month and Type-IV and above accommodation as 25 times of the License fees.

1. It is to report that the Executive Council vide Resolution No. 40 dated 16.08.2013 has duly authorized the Vice-Chancellor to take all necessary administrative and legal steps to disallow the proposed construction in the North Campus of the University of Delhi in the parking lot of Vishwavidyalaya Metro Station. The University has also written to the various Statutory Bodies opposing said construction.
2. The Appeal No. 112 / 2018 titled *University of Delhi Vs Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change & Ors* filed before Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT), challenging the Environmental Clearance (EC) dated 23.03.2018 issued by State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) of Delhi, in favour of M/s Young Builders Pvt. Ltd was disposed off vide judgment dated 20.01.2021. The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal while disposing the said appeal has noted and observed as following:

*“12. .... learned Senior Counsel for the project proponent made a statement that as per his instructions, the project proponent has to apply for fresh EC to the MoEF&CC and the impugned EC will not be acted upon. Learned Counsel for the appellant states that if the impugned EC is not to be acted upon and the matter is to be considered a fresh by the MoEF&CC on merits the appeal may be disposed of as infructuous, without prejudice to the rights to challenge the fresh EC which may be granted.*

*13. In view of above stand of the parties, it is no longer necessary for this Tribunal to go into the merits and express any final view about viability of the project or otherwise.*

*14. Accordingly, the appeal is disposed of as infructuous, without prejudice to the rights and remedies of the parties in accordance with law. In view of order in the main appeal, all pending I.A.s will stand disposed of.”*

3. That Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) considered the fresh application filed by the project proponent *i.e.* M/s Young Builders Pvt. Ltd. for the 'EC' (Environment Clearance) with extended built up area of 1,37,879 m<sup>2</sup> from the earlier 1,17,733.81 sq.m, extended floors of 2 basement + 43 floors from earlier S+G+37 Floors, extended 446 dwelling units from the earlier 410 dwelling units, extended total population of 2302 person from the earlier 1785 person and extended total height of the building of 145.3 meters from the earlier 139.6 meters. The University of Delhi also represented before the said EAC considering the application for EC of builder vide application dated 02.03.2021, against the application of builder. However, the said EAC vide it's 64<sup>th</sup> meeting dated 13.04.2021 considered the request of Project Proponent

and without giving any speaking observation on each of the findings towards contentions raised by the University of Delhi and without giving any opportunity on the representation dated 02.03.2021 recommended the project for the grant on EC arbitrarily. Accordingly, Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change , GoI, vide 21.05.2021 granted 'EC' in favour of the project proponent.

4. Feeling aggrieved with the said fresh 'EC' dated 21.05.2021 the University of Delhi has filed an Appeal No. 17/ 2021 titled *University of Delhi Vs Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change & Ors* challenging the same before the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal. The said appeal has been admitted for consideration vide order dated 27.08.2021 (**Appendix-LIII**) and an interim order was passed as following:

*"4. Issue Notice to Respondents – MoEF&CC and the PP. Shri Atmaram N.S. Nadkarni, Senior Advocate alongwith Mr. Mahesh Agarwal has entered appearance for Respondent No. 11. He seeks time and granted time to file response, if any, within one month. Notice may be served on MoEF&CC by e-mail by the registry as well as by the appellant. The appellant may file affidavit of service within one week. Response, if any, by MoEF&CC may be filed within one month. A photo copy of the record may be either filed with the registry or kept ready at the time of hearing.*
