

(from time to time) keeping in view adequate exposure and training in three to four areas across the entire MA programme for each of its students.

Group (C)

Note. Depending on the availability of a suitable faculty and availability of choices, **four** of these will be offered as compulsory/elective courses in the third semester. If adequate number of faculty is available, students will have the liberty to choose according to the criteria set by the Department. Students will have to choose at least one course each from (C-1) and (C-II).

Group (D)

Note. Depending on the availability of a suitable faculty and availability of choices, **four** of these will be offered as compulsory/elective courses in the fourth semester. If adequate number of faculty is available, students will have the liberty to choose according to the criteria set by the Department (to ensure adequate exposure and training in three to four areas across the entire MA programme).

Teaching:

The faculty of the Department is primarily responsible for organizing teaching for M.A. in Linguistics. The tutorials/**labs**, if possible, will be provided by engaging the research scholars under the overall guidance of the Department. Teaching comprises lectures, demonstration, field /Lab projects, data oriented analytical exercises.

There shall be 90 instructional days excluding examination in a semester.

Projects/Dissertation:

Students have the option to choose Research Based Dissertation in Semester 4 at the M.A. level as part of Group D courses. In addition, there are ample opportunities for carrying out research projects and producing research reports/ term papers as part of the teaching practices of the department. Students are encouraged to participate in Faculty research projects to enhance their methodological and analytical abilities.
