Minor Amendments/Corrections in the Proposed to the PG (MA) syllabus accepted in 2019

(Duly passed in CC and Arts Faculty/BR)

(1) A minor correction/amendment is proposed to rectify the anomaly arising out of the incorrect number of credits (inadvertently) assigned to two Open Elective and two Workshop courses in the recently AC/EC approved syllabus. This has been corrected to 5 credits per course as indicated on Pages 9-11 and as per the rules of the University.

(2) A note on Post-MA Diploma and Advanced Diploma course structure and syllabus are also mentioned which were inadvertently left out from this document but mentioned on our website and earlier syllabus.

Since the teaching of the MA and Diploma course is the same, changes will also apply to the Post MA Diploma (I year, same as MA I) and Advanced Diploma (1 year, same as MA II).

The Diploma Syllabuses have also been submitted after due approval at the CC/DRC and the Arts Faculty/BRS \.
