**3/- The Council also observed 2 minutes silence on the sad demise of the Teaching Faculty and Non Teaching members of University of Delhi during covid pandemic.**

**4/-** Resolved that the Minutes of the meeting of the Academic Council held on 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 were confirmed. (**Appendix –1**)

However, with regard to Res. No. 11-4/- it was observed that in future the representation of elected A.C./E.C. Members be made in such Committees.

**5/-** The action taken on the Minutes of the meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 of the Academic Council was reported and recorded. No matter was raised on the minutes of the meeting dated 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2020. (**Appendix – 2**)

**6/-** Resolved that the recommendations of the Faculty of Law made at its meeting held on 29.05.2021 to waive off the fees on account of amount charged for printed Case Materials provided to the LL.B. and LL.M. students (Rs. 1000/- per semester in case of LL.B. students and Rs. 1250/- in case of LL.M. students) as the same shall be provided online, be accepted and recommended for consideration of Executive Council.

**7/-** Resolved that the recommendations of the Faculty of Applied Social Sciences and Humanities made at its meeting held on 09.07.2021 regarding syllabus of one year diploma course in Mass Media and Film Studies were accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for approval. The Council also recommended that the consequential amendments to the relevant Ordinance of the University be made accordingly. (**Appendix-3**)

**8/-** Resolved that the recommendations of the Standing Committee (Scholarships) made at its meeting held on 26.02.2021 regarding increasing one more number of scholarship instead of two scholarship to each (1) “Sneh Rana Scholarship” (2) “P.S. Rana Scholarship” were accepted and recommended for consideration of Executive Council. The Council also recommended that the consequential amendments to the relevant Ordinance of the University be made accordingly. (**Appendix-4**)

The Standing Committee (Scholarships) has already instituted the said scholarship namely “Sneh Rana Scholarship” and “P.S. Rana Scholarship” with the endowment of Rs. Ten Lakhs to each. The donor has already deposited Rs. Six Lakhs in the said scholarship i.e. Rs. Three Lakhs to each and Committee decided to accept the same. Now the donor has requested to increase one number of scholarships to the following:

Resolved that the recommendations of the Standing Committee (New Courses) made at its meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 regarding introduction of new courses to the Colleges/Institutions be accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.(**Appendix-5**)

However, before starting the Course(s) the College(s) must obtain a candid approval of the funding agency in respect of the following:-

1. Sanction of Teaching post(s); Non Teaching post(s) including Lab. Staff as applicable.
2. Financial support for smooth running of course(s).

**10/-** Resolved that the the recommendations of the Faculty of Social Sciences made at its meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 regarding change of nomenclature from Developing Countries Research Centre to Centre for Global Studies were accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for approval. The Council also recommended that the consequential amendments to the relevant Ordinance of the University be made accordingly.(**Appendix-6**).

**11/-** Resolved that the de-affiliation of Delhi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Research (DIPSAR) from the University of Delhi, in terms of Statute 30(1)(C)(v) of the Statutes of the University be accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.

**12/-** The Council resolved and accepted the following recommendations of the Standing Committee on Academic Matters made at its meeting held on 23.08.2021 and recommended to the Executive Council for approval. The Council also recommended that the consequential amendments to the relevant Ordinance of the University be made accordingly.

**12-1/** Recommendations of the Committee for implementing National Education Policy 2020 (NEP) as under:

1. The NEP 2020 should be implemented in the University from the Academic Year 2022-23.

**(Nineteen Members dissented)**

2. The structure of Under-Graduate Programmes recommended by the NEP Implementation Committee (**Appendix-7**) were accepted. Shuffling of papers across semester(s) within the structure can be done with the approval of the Academic Council.

**(Eighteen Members dissented)**

3. (a).The quality of the degree conferred by the University should not be compromised. Accordingly, the existing structure and workload should

continue along with addition of various courses under Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Value Addition Courses (VAC) etc. so as to make it holistic and multidisciplinary in line with UGC letter No. D.No. F.2-8/2021 dated 22.07.2021 (**Appendix-8**).

b). To infuse holistic and multidisciplinary education while maintaining the quality of education, the number of credits determined by the NEP Implementation Committee for each academic level (Levels 5, 6, 7 and 8) was recommended to be adopted. Further, it was noted that it would not only be amenable to the existing framework but also imbibe the spirit of NEP 2020 to make develop competent and well-rounded individuals.

(c). The various additional courses proposed by the NEP Implementation Committee, such as Language and Literature, Social and Emotional Learning, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Co-curricular, Ethics and Culture, IT Skills, Data Analysis and Mathematics, Science and Society etc. as well as the existing courses which will continue to run, shall be framed/revised in tune with the spirit of NEP 2020 so as to enable their implementation in 2022-23.

(d). The steps taken in the direction to lay the foundation of holistic and multidisciplinary education in higher education shall be communicated to the UGC once the concrete framework of these courses shall be designed.

4. The Multiple entry and Exit Scheme (MEES) and Academic Bank of Credit shall be implemented in the University, keeping in view the maintenance of standard of education by emphasizing on the core courses in the University and allowing the credits to be earned from other universities with respect to other courses. It was also decided that the detailed modalities need to be worked out for rolling out the MEES and ABC. The details of the same shall be worked out separately in line with UGC letter No. D.No. F.2-8/2021 (IoE-NEP) dated 19.07.2021 (**Appendix-9**).

**(Seventeen Members dissented)**

5. The University shall retain the 3 years Honours Degree as well as well as assimilate in its structure the 4 years Honours Degree and 4 years Honours Degree with Research.
6. The University to implement both one year and two years Post-Graduate Programme in line with the existing structure and that of NEP 2020.
7. The Committee recommends the following for lateral entry / re-entry of students:
  - a) For students of other Universities registered under Academic Bank Credit system, lateral entry of eligible students be allowed into the University after conducting entrance test;
  - b) The seats for lateral entry may be worked out on the basis of the academic and infrastructural facilities available keeping in view the relevant norms, such as student-teacher ratio, teaching-non-teaching staff ratio, laboratory, library, teaching learning tools, etc.
  - c) For students of the University of Delhi and its Colleges, re-entry may be allowed.
8. The inclusion of NCC course as General Elective Credit Course at UG level be taken into consideration while formulating the detailed course structure in line



with UGC letters No. D.O. No. 1-18/2019 (CPP-II) dated 18.04.2021 & 09.07.2021 (**Appendix-10**).

9. The existing M.Phil. Programme to be discontinued from the academic year 2022-23 in line with the NEP 2020.

**12-2/** Resolved that the following recommendations of the Faculty of Social Sciences made at its meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2021 be accepted and recommended to the Academic Council for consideration:

- (a). Proposed Papers based on LOCF for General Elective Course in Undergraduate Level under the Department of Adult Continuing Education & Extension. (**Appendix-11**)
- (b). Revised Syllabus of M.A. Japanese under the department of East Asian Studies. (**Appendix-12**)
- (c). Introduction of M.A. in International Relations and African Studies under the department of African Studies be referred back to the Faculty.
- (d). Introduction of one year PG Diploma in International Trade (Africa) under the department of African Studies from the Academic Session 2022-2023 (**Appendix-13**)

**12-3/** Resolved that the recommendations of the Faculty of Inter-Disciplinary and Applied Sciences at its meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> August 2021 regarding Rearrangement of papers between semesters in the CBCS-LOCF curriculum of the M.Sc. Biochemistry Course under the Department of Biochemistry were accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for consideration. (**Appendix-14**)

**12-4/** Resolved that the recommendations of the Faculty of Inter-Disciplinary and Applied Sciences at its meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> August 2021 regarding Rearrangement and reshuffle of the M.Sc. Biophysics curriculum under the Department of Biophysics were accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for consideration. (**Appendix-15**)

**13/** **Ref.: E.C. Res. No. 49 dated 08.12.2020**

Resolved that the recommendations of the Advisory Committee of the Centre for Himalayan Studies made at its meeting held on 11.08.2021 regarding proposal for inclusion of Ordinance of Centre for Himalayan Studies under Ordinance XX of the Ordinances of the University be accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for approval. The Council also recommended that the consequential amendments to the relevant Ordinance of the University be made accordingly. (**Appendix-16**)

**14/** **Ref.: E.C. Res. No. 199(6) dated 23.12.2009**

Resolved that the recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for empanelment of Adjunct Faculty in the University Departments and Colleges, for value addition and internationalization of the academic activities, to engage international Adjunct faculty from their own resources to significantly enhance the Teaching-learning Process in the University of Delhi as per Ordinance XII-C (1)/EC Resolution dated 23.12.2009 were accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for approval. (**Appendix-17**).

**(Four Members dissented)**

**15/-** Resolved that the Vice-Chancellor be authorized to take the decision on the request of Director (Higher Education), Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Delhi in providing the comments of the University of Delhi on the draft Cabinet Note regarding the proposal of merger of

College of Arts (COA) of the University in Ambedkar University, Delhi and recommended for Executive Council for consideration.(**Appendix-18**)

**16/-** Resolved that the recommendations of the Delhi University Digital Infrastructure Supports for Colleges and Departments Committee (DUDISCAD) were accepted and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.(**Appendix-19**).

**17/-** The Council noted that the University of Delhi was allotted land measuring 16.35 acres at Roshan Pura Nazafgarh, Delhi and 40 Bigas of land at Bhati Kalan, Fatehpur Beri, South Delhi, New Delhi by Government of NCT Delhi.

On these piece of land University has decided to set up facilitation centers to cater to the needs and the requirements of students staying in far flung areas of Delhi and NCR as a first step toward opening a full fledged college.Through, these facilitation centers, examination and admission related facilities will be extended to the students.

The Council resolved that the name of these Colleges/Centers may be given after the names of Sushma Swaraj, Swami Vivekananda, Veer Savarkar, Sardar Patel.
