It is submitted that a meeting of the Dean of Colleges, Director SDC, Registrar, DSW and Dean Admission under the Chairmanship of Pro-Vice Chancellor was held on 10.12.2020 wherein the following was resolved:

- I. The members observed that the Ward Quota already exists in the UG Courses (merit based) and that the admissions in these courses are almost complete. Accordingly the Academic Council Resolution dated 27.11.2020 in respect of UG courses is only enhancement of the number of seats in each colleges, hence, be implemented from the next Academic Session.
- II. The committee observed that there is no provision of Ward Quota in admission in PG courses and also the fact that the admissions in the PG courses for the Academic Session 2020-21 are in the initial stages. Accordingly the committee resolved to extend the benefit of Ward Quota as per the Academic Council Resolution dated 27.11.2020 in PG courses from the current Academic Session i.e. 2020-21.
- III. The committee also considered the request from the Principals of the Colleges for admission in the UG courses under Discretionary Quota which will be over and above the sanctioned strength and supernumerary in nature and accepted the same.
- IV. It was also decided that a committee be constituted to propose the modalities and supervise implementation of Ward Quota as per Academic Council Resolution dated 27.11.2020 in PG courses from the current Academic Session 2020-21 and also the procedure, admission and number of seats to be earmarked under Discretionary Quota to be introduced for the Undergraduate admissions only.

Accordingly the file is submitted for constitution of the committee.

Accordingly, the AC Resolution No. 9 dated 27.11.2020 in respect of UG Courses is only enhancement of number of seats in each college hence be implemented from the next Academic Session i.e. 2021-2022.
3. It is pertinent to submit that the recommendation regarding 5 "College – University Seats" in UG Courses (merit based) in this Academic Session i.e. 2020-2021 be considered for approval in view of the COVID-19 pandemic. The complete recommendations may also be reported to the Academic Council at its next meeting.
4. A Notification outlining the modalities of implementation of Ward Quota in the PG Courses from the Academic Session 2020-2021 may be issued. A draft of the Notification is placed below.
5. The modalities of the recommendation of the committee regarding admission under "College – University seats" may also be notified for its implementation from this Academic Session. A draft of the Notification is placed below.

NOTIFICATION

In accordance with the Academic Council Resolution No. 9 dated 27.11.2020, the Competent Authority of the University has approved implementation of Ward Quota to the applicants of PG Courses of the University of Delhi from the Academic Session 2020-2021. The following modalities have been also been approved for implementation of Ward Quota admissions in PG Courses for the Academic Session 2020-2021:

- The LL.B., B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses are governed by the respective regulatory bodies like Bar Council of India (BCI) and National Council for Teachers Education (NCTE). The benefit of ward quota may be extended for admission in these courses from the session 2021-22.
- It was decided that for PG Courses where the sanctioned strength is up to 50 seats, only two ward quota seats be allocated wherein 1(one) in merit and 1(one) in entrance mode. In these courses, the merit of the candidates eligible under ward quota will be prepared by a combined merit of wards of teaching and non-teaching employees.
- The number of seats under ward quota for various courses as per their total sanctioned strength may be distributed as under:

- The seats as per above distribution shall be interchangeable within the category and also inter category subject to availability of candidates in order to maximize the benefit being extended.
- The eligible candidates be asked to upload proof with validity of either parent being University and/or its College employee.

- vi) The candidates be asked to submit preference of the courses in which he/she is seeking admission, if applied in more than 1(one) courses.
- vii) The candidates eligible to take admission in more than 1 course will be given choice to take admission in 1 course of the order of preference.
- viii) Once the preference of courses is received, the allocation of seats as per the matrix above will be done based on respective merit to be decided by the University constituted committee.
- ix) After completion of 1st round of admission, next round will commence only if the seats as distributed above are vacant and there are eligible candidates available.
