Qualifications:

1. Director, Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Centre for Biomedical Research:

Essential Qualification:

A.

- (i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research in Biomedical Science with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in University/College as Assistant Professor/ Associate Professor/ Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

Or

B.

An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. Degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in Biomedical Science and concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided she/he has ten years' experience.

Desirable Qualifications:

- (i) Minimum five years as a Professor in a University, Scientist in Professor's scale with administrative experience and leadership quality.
- (ii) Recognition at National/International level with experience of heading a Department/Institution.
- (iii) Independent research evident from publications in the field of Bio-medical Sciences.

Tenure: 5 year term. The term could be extended for not more than another term as per UGC guidelines.

2. Principal, University College of Medical Sciences:

Essential Qualification:

Should possess the recognized postgraduate medical qualifications and other academic qualifications from a recognized institution.

Teaching/Research Experience

A minimum of ten years' teaching experience as Professor/Associate Professor/Reader in a Medical College/Institute, out of which at least five years should be as Professor in a department. Preference for this appointment may be given to the Heads of the Department.

Tenure: 5 year term. The term could be extended for not more than another term as per UGC guidelines.
