Applications are invited for 10 posts of Assistant Professor on Guest Faculty basis in Department of Buddhist Studies, University of Delhi as per details here below –

Assistant Professor (Guest Faculty) 10 posts (UR-03, SC-02, ST-01, OBC-03, EWS - 01)

The candidates applying for the above positions should possess qualifications prescribed for the post of Assistant Professor as per University of Delhi / UGC guidelines and rules and regulations and their name must figure in the Panel of ad-hoc / guest faculty prepared by the Department of Buddhist Studies.

The candidates should have a good academic record with atleast 55% marks (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST and those who passed their Master's degree prior to 10.09.1991 and hold Ph.D. degree) or an equivalent grade at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject or an equivalent qualification from an Indian or foreign University. Candidates, besides fulfilling the above qualifications, should have cleared the eligibility test for lecturers (NET) conducted by UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC. However, the exemption from NET shall be applicable as per UGC prescribed norms / rules.

The interested candidates should e-mail duly filled in application as per enclosed format along with their Curriculum Vitae and self-attested copies of all documents, certificates / testimonials and publications in a single pdf file to <u>bsadhocguest2020@gmail.com</u> on or before 10th October 2021. The candidates should also mention in the e-mail their respective field of specialisation at M.A. level.

The date of interview shall be announced later on the University of Delhi website. When appearing for the interview, all candidates must fulfil the required educational and other eligibility criteria as per University of Delhi / UGC guidelines and rules and regulations. The hard copy of all relevant documents should be carried by the candidates attending the interview No TA/DA shall be reimbursed to the candidates attending the interview. The norms of social distancing, safety and health should be observed during the interview.
