Minutes of the Third Meeting of the Committee for Empanelment of Adjunct Faculty

The third meeting of the Committee for Empanelment of Adjunct Faculty was held on 18.11.2021 at 2:30 p.m. in the VC Committee Room of the University of Delhi.

The following attended the meeting:

Chair, Research Council, Dean Research, Social Sciences & Humanities and Dean Research, Life Sciences were unable to attend the meeting due to prior engagements.

The agenda of the meeting were as follows :

- A. To screen the nominations received from the Departments for empanelment of overseas Adjunct Faculty by using the approved guidelines.
- B. To deliberate on the amount of honorarium and other expenses (budget head) that may be proposed for payment to adjunct faculty.
- C. To discuss the possibility for empanelment of national adjunct faculty.

Based on the extensive deliberations, the following recommendations were made:

- A) The Committee screened the proposed nominations received on the basis of the criteria approved by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and recommended the selection of the following as Adjunct Faculty of the University of Delhi:
- 1. Prof. (Dr.) Christopher LEN, Chimie ParisTech, Institute of Chemistry for Life and Health Sciences, University of Paris
- 2. Prof. (Dr.) Erik V. Van der Eycken, Department of Chemistry, University of Leuven (KU Leuven)
- 3. Prof. (Dr.) Reiser, Oliver, Institute of Organic Chemistry, University of Regensburg
- 4. Prof. (Dr.) Debasish Sinha, Ophthalmology, University of Pittsburgh
- 5. Prof. (Dr.) Pradip Raychaudhuri, Department of Biochemistry & Molecular Genetics, University of Illinois at Chicago
- 6. Prof. (Dr.) Christian Betzel, Institute of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, University of Hamburg
- 7. Prof. (Dr.) Eddy Arnold, Chemistry and Chemical Biology, Rutgers University.
- 8. Prof. (Dr.) Hilary Inyang Inyang, Global Institute for Sustainable Development, Global Institute for Sustainable Development, Concord
- 9. Prof. (Dr.) Shanta Pandey, School of Social Work, Boston College
- 10. Prof. (Dr.) Hussein Payandeh, Allama Tabatbai University

The committee felt that two nominations pertaining to Dr. Kheswar Jankee, Department of Economics and Statistics, University of Mauritius and Dr. Mohammad-Kazem Kahdouei, Persian Language and Literature, Yazd University required more information to be able to decide, especially their significance to the academic development of the concerned Department and related disciplines. Accordingly, it was decided that the concerned Head(s) of Department(s) and Dean of the Faculty may be requested to provide the same so as to enable the Committee to examine the same in the next cycle.

Further, it was also decided that the Head of the Departments may be invited to send fresh nominations for the second cycle of selection of Adjunct Faculty as per approved procedure.

- B) After due deliberations, the Committee decided to propose the following budget for expenses towards Adjunct Faculty:
 - I. Monthly honorarium to a maximum of Rs. 80,000 (@Rs. 4000 per day)
 - II. One visit to the department per semester i.e. at the most, 2 visits per academic year, for a maximum stay of one month per visit and minimum of two weeks
 - III. Cost of air travel in economy class
 - IV. Medical insurance expenses for the period of stay in India
 - V. Local travel expenses, as per actuals
 - VI. Free lodging and boarding in the University's International Guest House .

Departments are expected to arrange office space for the Adjunct Faculties .

- C) The Committee discussed the matter pertaining to the engagement of national level Adjunct Faculty in the departments of the University. The Committee, keeping in view that -
 - the budget head for engagement of overseas Adjunct Faculty is yet to be created,
 - Departments have infrastructural limitations to provide logistic support to Adjunct Faculties, and
 - Adjunct Faculties are being or going to be engaged for the first time in this semester, the challenges that arises in the same are yet to be known,

was of the opinion that the proposal for empanelment of national Adjunct Faculty may be re-visited after one semester of engagement of overseas Adjunct Faculties.
