The meeting started with National Anthem.

WELCOME

19/- At the outset, the Registrar read out the following welcome note, introducing and welcoming Professor Yogesh Singh who had joined as Vice-Chancellor of the University on 08.10.2021:

It is indeed an honour to inform the Council that Hon'ble Visitor (The President of India) has appointed Professor Yogesh Singh as the Vice Chancellor of the University of Delhi. Professor Yogesh Singh assumed the charge of the Vice Chancellor on 8th October, 2021 (A/N). Prior to that he was the Vice Chancellor of Delhi Technological University. Prior to that he has been the Director of Netaji Subhas Institute of Technology, Delhi (December 31, 2014 to July 24, 2017) and Vice Chancellor of Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Gujarat (July 07, 2011 to December 29, 2014). Government of Gujarat had given him the second term of Vice Chancellor, Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, which he continued up till December 29, 2014.

He received his M.Tech. (Electronics & Communication Engineering) and Ph.D.(Computer Engineering) degrees from National Institute of Technology, Kurukshetra, Haryana. He has supervised 23 Ph.Ds in the area of Software Engineering. He has more than 250 publications in International and National Journals/Conferences.

He wrote a book on "Software Testing" published by Cambridge University Press, England (2011). He has also co-authored books on Software Engineering published by New Age International Delhi (2002), and Object Oriented Software Engineering published by PHI Learning, Delhi (2012). Prof. Yogesh Singh participated in YALE-INDIA LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME in Yale University, USA (2011).

He is a member of the Executive Committee of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with effect from October 03, 2019. He is also an independent Director of Gujarat State Petro Net Ltd. and Gujarat State Petroleum Corporations Ltd. (Government of Gujarat Undertakings) since May, 2013 and March, 2015 respectively. He is appointed as the Additional Director (Non-Executive, Independent Director) on the Board of Director of Gujarat Gas for the tenure of 5 years w.e.f. from 15 August, 2021. Prof. Yogesh Singh is the Chairman of Governing Board of Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre, Gandhinagar, an Autonomous Inter-University Centre (IUC) of University Grants Commission, New Delhi (Ministry of Education, Govt. of India).

Prof. Singh was the Chairman, Central Regional Committee, All India Council for Technical Education, Bhopal (covering States of Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh & Gujarat) from December 2011 to May 2014. He was member of the General Council of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and was also the member of the Governing Council of Association of Indian Universities.

He has served as Dean, University School of Information Technology (2001-2006), Controller of Examinations (2006-2011) and Director Students Welfare of Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, Delhi.

On behalf of the Executive Council, I have the privilege and honour to welcome Professor Yogesh Singh as the Vice-Chancellor of this University and as the Chairman of the Executive Council as per the provisions of Statute 5(1)(i).

21/- The Council expressed condolence on the sad demise of Prof. J.P. Khurana, former Pro-Vice Chancellor, Director, South Campus and Dean of Colleges who left for heavenly abode on 27.10.2021.

“Prof. J.P. Khurana was the Pro-Vice Chancellor from 01.06.2016 to 15.11.2019. He was interim Dean of Colleges from 28.07.2016 to 05.09.2016, 08.02.2018 to 03.04.2018, 04.07.2018 to 31.10.2019. Prof. Khurana also served as Director, South Campus w.e.f. 27.05.2016 to 31.10.2019.

Dr. Jitendra Paul Khurana was the Professor in the Department of Plant Molecular Biology, University of Delhi South Campus. He had his early education in Delhi and obtained Ph.D. in Botany from University of Delhi. He did his Post-doctoral work at the Smithsonian Institution in Washington DC, and at the Michigan State University, in the mid-1980s. He returned to India to join the newly established Department of Plant Molecular Biology at South Campus in the year 1988 and has been there ever since. He made short visits to US Department of Agriculture (USDA), Beltsville, in 1996 and 1998, under the Indo-US exchange programme. Subsequently, he was a visiting Professor at the Waksman Institute of Microbiology of the Rutgers University, USA, in 2001. He has served as a member of several scientific committees of the DBT, DST, CSIR and ICAR, and Advisory Committees of various Indian Universities and Institutes.

Professor Khurana contributed significantly to the sequencing of genomes of the crop plants like rice, tomato and wheat, as part of International Consortia. He has published nearly 140 research articles in refereed international journals, including ‘Nature’, ‘Science’, ‘Genome Research’, ‘Nucleic Acids Research’, ‘Plant Physiology’, and ‘Plant Cell & Environment’. In the past nearly 28 years, he has supervised 25 Ph.D. students and several post-doctoral Fellows.

For his scientific contributions, Professor Khurana has been honoured with several fellowships and awards. He is Fellow of the National Academy of Sciences (NASI), Allahabad; Fellow of the Indian National Science Academy (INSA), New Delhi; Fellow of the Indian Academy of Sciences (IASc), Bangalore; Fellow of the National Academy of Agricultural Sciences (NAAS), New Delhi; Fellow of The World Academy of Sciences (TWAS), Trieste, Italy.

For his overall scientific contributions in the area of plant biology, Professor Khurana was awarded 'Tata Innovation Fellowship' by the DBT and also availed J.C. Bose National Fellowship awarded by the DST."

The Executive Council observed two minutes silence as a mark of respect for the departed soul.

22/- The Executive Council decided to insert the recommendations of the ICC in Resolution No. 14-1 before the paragraph "The Executive Council after deliberation....."

Insertion:

"The ICC has made the following recommendations:

- (i) Respondent No. 1 shall be 'Censured' for his misconduct;
- (ii) Other respondents shall be issued a warning in writing;
- (iii) Respondent No. 1 and Respondents shall not participate in the interviews of the Complainant in future, in order to maintain fairness in the selection process;
- (iv) In the course of inquiry, many instances of mental harassment and improprieties by Respondent No. 1 as Head of the Department were reported before ICC. Since other forms of harassment do not fall within the mandate of ICC, in the given circumstances, ICC recommends to the University constitute an independent inquiry committee to examine other forms of harassment;
- (v) The University shall issue an Advisory to all the Deans and Heads to take proactive steps to prevent the acts of sexual harassment and maintain due respect for gender justice;
- (vi) The University shall mandate the inclusion of at least one woman in all Selection Committee of the University."

Thereafter, the Minutes of the meeting of the Executive Council held on 31.08.2021 (**Appendix-I**) were confirmed with the above amendments.

23/- The Executive Council desired that the decision taken with regard to Resolution No. 6 be reported to the Executive Council. Further, with regard to Resolution No. 8-11, it was informed that the colleges to be opened shall be on the names of Veer Savarkar and Sushma Swaraj as decided by the then Vice Chancellor (Actg.), Prof. P.C. Joshi.

Thereafter, the Action Taken Report on the decisions made by the Executive Council at its meeting held on 31.08.2021 (**Appendix-II**) were noted.

27/- The Executive Council considered and approved the **Separate Audit Report (SAR) received from the Director General of Audit, (Home, Education and Skill Development) on the Annual Account of the University for the year 2019-20 (Appendix-V).**

The un-audited Annual Accounts for the year 2019-20 has already been considered and approved by the Finance Committee and Executive Council at its meeting held on 11th January, 2021 and 18th March, 2021 (E.C. Resolution No. 64 dated 18.03.2021) respectively.

The Separate Audit Report (SAR) received from the Director General of Audit, (Home Education and Skill Development) on the Annual Accounts of the University for the Year 2019-20 was approved by the Finance Committee in its meeting held on 27.10.2021 and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.

28/- The Executive Council considered and approved the **Annual Accounts of the University, its maintained Halls & Hostel, Delhi University Press, Provident Fund and New Pension Scheme for the Financial Year 2020-21 (Appendix-VI).**

The Finance Committee in its meeting held on 27.10.2021 considered the un-audited Annual Accounts for the Financial Year 2020-21 and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.

29/- The Executive Council resolved and accepted the following recommendations made by the Finance Committee at its meeting held on 27.10.2021 as under:

29-2. Statement of allocation of grant under the budget heads 'Salary', 'Recurring' and 'Capital Assets' for the Financial Year 2021-22 by the UGC and status of expenditure by the University as on 30.09.2021 was noted by the Executive Council. The Executive Council observed that the grants allocated by the UGC for the Financial Year 2021-2022 are not sufficient and the University may take up the matter with the University Grants Commission for enhancement of allocation.

29-3. The matter regarding refund of Unutilized Grant under various Plan Schemes/ XII Plan, GDA etc. was discussed. It was noted that the University is entering into its centenary year of celebration and in order to maintain its halls, departments, University accommodations which are more than 40 to 50 years old and are in dilapidated conditions, needs for urgent repair / renovation and also to execute various essential projects, the funds are urgently required. Besides this, several repair and renovation projects are also to be undertaken on priority to avoid any mis-happening.

It was resolved that the Vice Chancellor be authorized to take up the matter with the UGC/Ministry to allow the University to utilize the unspent funds under various Plan Schemes/ XII Plan, GDA etc..

29-4. The recommendations of the Finance Committee approving the Internal Audit Manual (**Appendix-VII**) was accepted by the Executive Council.

29-5. The recommendations of the Building Committee meetings held on 20.7.2021 and 14.9.2021 as accepted by the Finance Committee were approved by the Executive Council.
