After due deliberation, the Committee recommended the Revised Budget Estimates for the year 2021-22 to the tune of Rs.92993.00 lakh be placed before the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

BUDGET ESTIMATES - 2022-23

The Committee also noted the Budget Estimates for the year 2022-23 works out to Rs.244117.00 lakh as follows:

- Rs.82228.00 lakh under Salary (OH-36) head which includes salaries, personal claims and retirement benefits etc.
- Rs.52603.00 lakh under Recurring (OH-31) head which includes Pension and Pensionary benefits, Non-Salary and Non-NET Fellowships for M.Phil./Ph.D. holders.
- Rs.109286.00 lakh for Capital Assets (OH-35).

The Committee recommended that the Revised Budgeted Estimates – 2021-22 and Budget Estimates – 2022-23 be placed before the Executive Council for consideration and approval keeping in view of the observations of MoE (IFD) "that the estimates are based on a realistic assessment of requirement of funds for the University and also subject to availability of funds with UGC, the proposal may be recommended for approval."

After a brief discussion, the Committee noted the status of Public Grievances and Status of Parliamentary Assurances.

BUILDING **OF** THE RECOMMENDATIONS THE CONSIDER 09/ TO

COMMITTEE The recommendations of the Building Committee meeting held on 11.03.2022 has been accepted and recommended for approval to the Executive Council.

This also includes the revised preliminary estimated cost of 4 Building projects which has already been approved by the Finance Committee in its meeting held on 27.10.2021 and approved by MOE for allocation under EWS Scheme. The Finance Committee considered the recommendation of the Building Committee held on 11.03.2022 and accepted the same. Now the revised cost is Rs. 226.426 Crores for the following projects:

- Rs. 38.852 Crores Vertical extension of multi-storey building of 1. Physics and Chemistry Department (Science Block) - Rs. 16.45 Crores
- Vertical extension of Computer Centre 2. - Rs. 27.17 Crores Vertical extension of Central Reference Library
- 3. Construction of New Girls Hostel at Dhaka Complex - Rs. 143.954 Crores 4. for accommodating 700 girl students under EWS

TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL FOR SUBMISSION TO HEFA FOR 10/ FUNDING FOR INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT AND CREATION OF CAPITAL ASSETS

The Committee deliberated on the comments received from the UGC and MoE vide email dated 15.3.2022 & 16.3.2022. The projected Fund Flow Statement (Annexure-I) for the next five years has been presented before the Committee members. After going through the requirement, the Committee accepted the proposal for fund from HEFA amounting to Rs.1075.40 crore and recommended for approval to the Executive Council.

TO CONSIDER THE REVISION OF ALLOWANCE OF VICE PRINCIPAL 11/ AND BURSAR IN DELHI UNIVERSISTY COLLEGES

The Committee considered the revision of allowance of Vice-Principal and Bursar in Delhi University Colleges and recommended to the Executive Council for approval as

Bursar Allowance Rs. 4,000/- p.m. Vice Principal Rs. 5,000/- p.m.

Further, the University may take up the matter with the UGC for concurrence before implementation.

TO CONSIDER THE REVISION OF HONORARIUM OF NON-TEACHING STAFF FOR WORKING ON SATURDAY AND HOLIDAY 12/

The Committee considered the remuneration proposed as under to the Non-Teaching staff for performing duties on Saturday/Holidays and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.

Officers working at level 10 and above —	Rs.1200/- (for 8 hours & Rs.750/- for 5 hours)
Employees working between level 6 & 9 -	Rs.1000/- (for 8 hours & Rs.600 for 5 hours)
Employees working between level 4 & 6 -	Rs.800/- (for 8 hours & Rs.500 for 5 hours)
Employees working below level 4	Rs.600/- (for 8 hours & Rs.300 for 4 hours)
