VIJAY KUMAR CHADHA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

1. There shall be a scholarship known as 'Vijay Kumar Chadha Memorial Scholarship' of the value of Rs.100/-p.m. to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs.25,000/- received from Shri D.N. Chadha of A-8, Rana Pratap Bagh, Delhi.
2. The scholarship shall be awarded to meritorious and needy student whose parents income including his/her own income does not exceed to the amount from where it starts attracting income tax, and who joins in the first year of the LL.B. Course in the Campus Law Centre, University of Delhi.
3. The scholarship shall be tenable for a period of two years renewable yearly on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardee.
4. a. No student shall be eligible for the award for this scholarship if he already holds a scholarship awarded by the Delhi University or any other University or the Central Governments, or any State Government or Private Body, other than Freeship.

b. In case any scholar accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he shall be required to refund the amount received by him on this account from the date he accepts the other scholarships/financial assistance.
5. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, he shall, after due warning, in writing, be reported by the Principal/Head of the Institution/Department to the Academic Council which may reduce, suspend or withdraw the scholarship.
6. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of a Selection Committee constituted as follows:-
 1. The Dean, Faculty of Law (Chairman)
 2. Professor-in-charge, Campus Law Centre
 3. One Senior Member of the Faculty of Law—(to be nominated by the Dean, Faculty of Law)
7. Applications for the scholarships, in the prescribed form obtainable from the office of the Registrar, (Scholarship Cell) should reach the Registrar, Delhi University, Delhi-7, through the Head of the Institution concerned by the date mentioned in the notification issued by the Registrar in this behalf.
8. The payment of the scholarship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Head of the Institution from May each years on presentation of a bill, a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill, the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
9. The scholarship shall be awarded after a period of two years
