DR. RAM KISHORE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS TO THE LL.B. STUDENT.

1. There shall be two scholarships^{*} known as "Dr. Ram Kishore Memorial Scholarship" of the value of Rs.250/-p.m.^{**} to be awarded every year to an LL.M. (two year course) student of each year out of the ~~annual income~~ accruing from the endowment fund of Rs.50,000/- received from the Senior Advocate Shri Brijbans Kishore S/o Late Dr. Ram Kishore, former Vice-Chancellor University of Delhi, (1934-1938).
2. The Scholarships shall be awarded every year to the deserving students on merit-cum-means basis on the performance at the LL.B. Final year examinations.
3. No student shall be eligible for award of this scholarship if he/she already holds scholarship awarded by the Delhi University or any other University or the Central Government, or any State Government or Private Body, other than freeship.

In case any scholar accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he/she shall be required to refunded the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.

4. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, he shall after due warning in writing be reported by the Principal/Head of the Institution/Department to the Academic Council which may reduce, suspend or withdraw the scholarship.
5. The scholarship shall be awarded by a Committee consisting of the following:-
 1. The Dean, Faculty of Law,
 2. Two Senior most Professors of each of the three Law Centres, i.e. Campus Law Centre, Law Centre No.I, Law Centre No.II by annual rotation.
6. The payment of the scholarships shall be made to the scholar through the Dean, Faculty of Law on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered under the bill the scholar was not in receipt of any other financial assistance from any source.
7. The unutilised amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.

** The value of the book grant be at the present accrued annual income on such endowment fund {SC(scholarship) meeting dated 27/1/04 }.
